

# Impaired driving charges laid in three incidents

Three Milton residents are facing drinking and driving charges stemming from separate incidents.

Just before 8 p.m. Saturday, police pulled over a vehicle on Ashbrook Court. A 46-year-old woman was charged with impaired driving and 'over 80.'

Monday at 6 a.m., police responded to a single-vehicle collision on Main Street in front of Bishop Reding Secondary School and charged a 21-year-old man with impaired driving and failing to provide a breath sample.

And Tuesday at about 8 p.m. in Acton, police conducting a RIDE spot check pulled over a vehicle after it turned onto a side street. The driver, a 44-year-old Milton man, was arrested and charged with 'over 80.'

## Snowmobile stolen from compound

Halton Regional Police are investigating a break-in to a local business.

Sometime between midnight and 6 a.m. December 18, unknown suspects entered the gated compound of Truck Town Service shop, 8201 Lawson Rd., and stole a snowmobile parked inside.

Further investigation by police revealed snowmobile tracks across the parking lot leading to a hole cut in the fence at the rear of the property.
