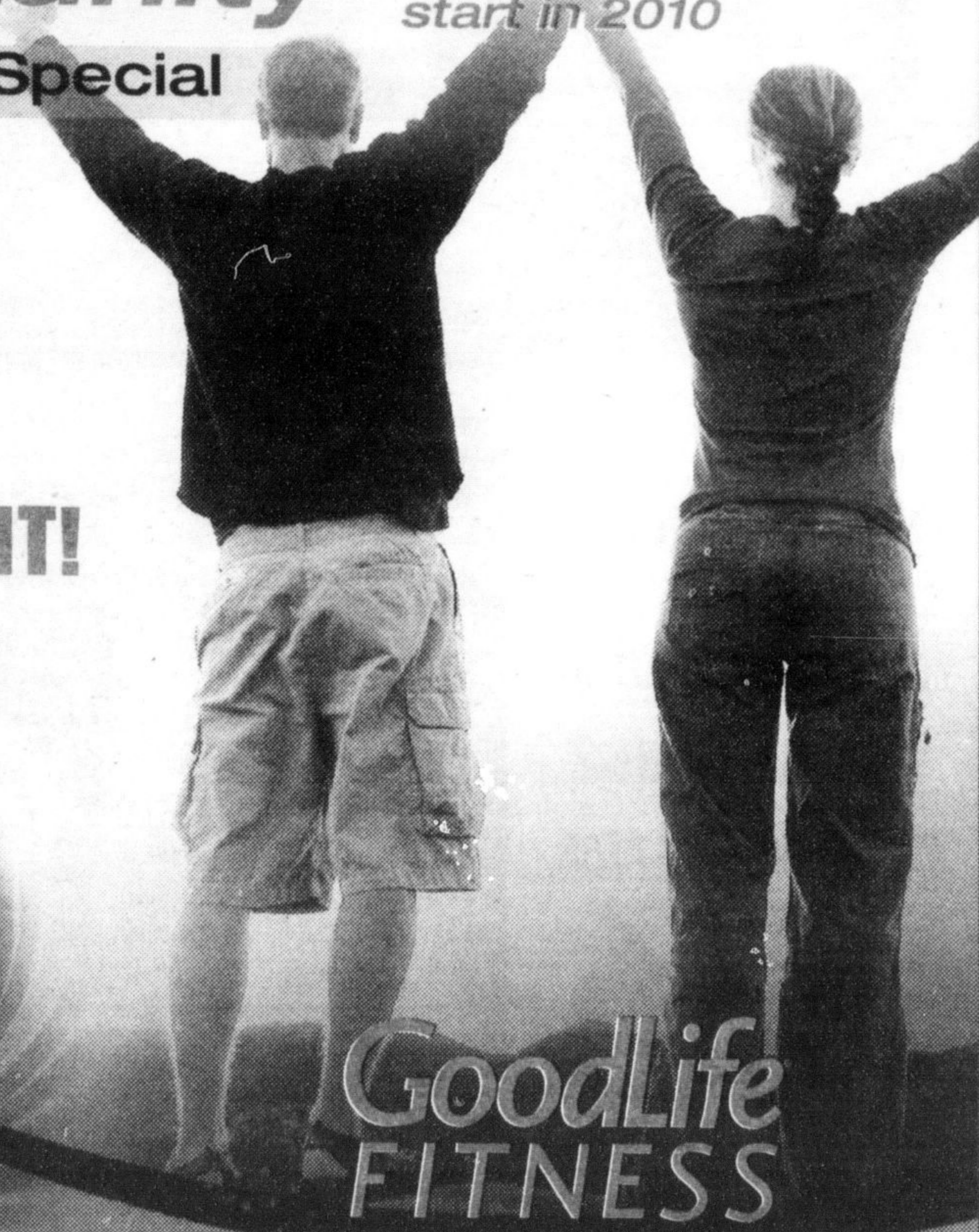

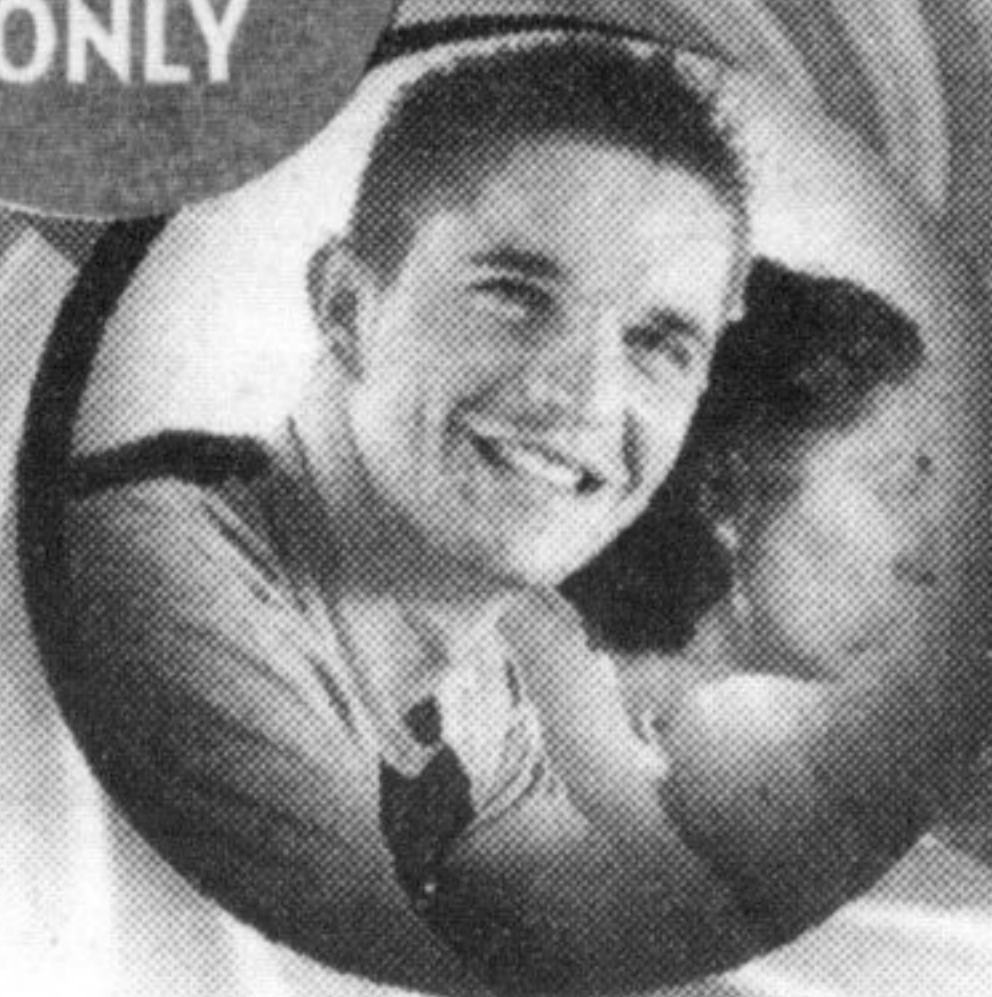

Persaud won playing Pro Picks Pools; he purchased his winning ticket at a Brampton convenience store.

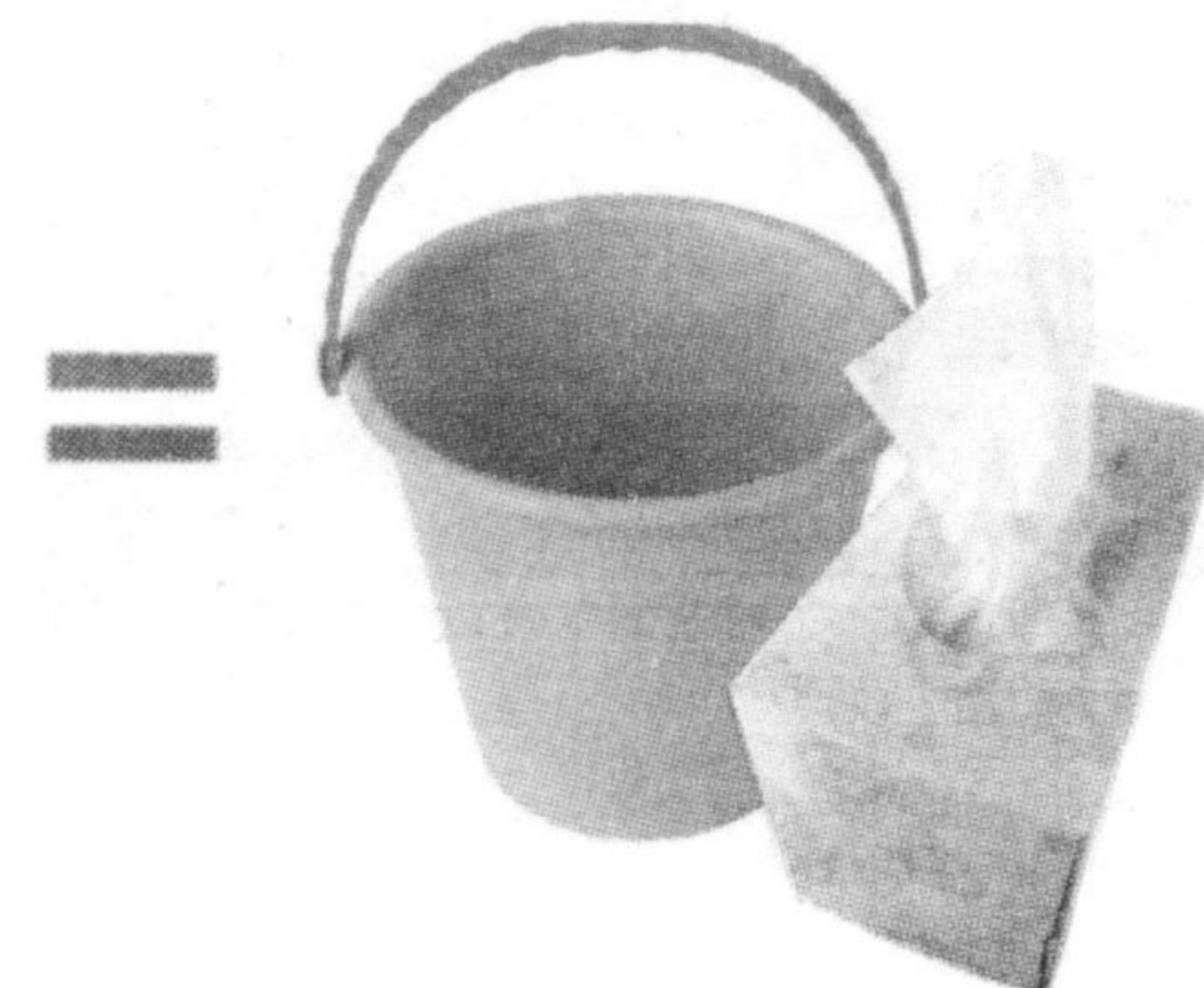
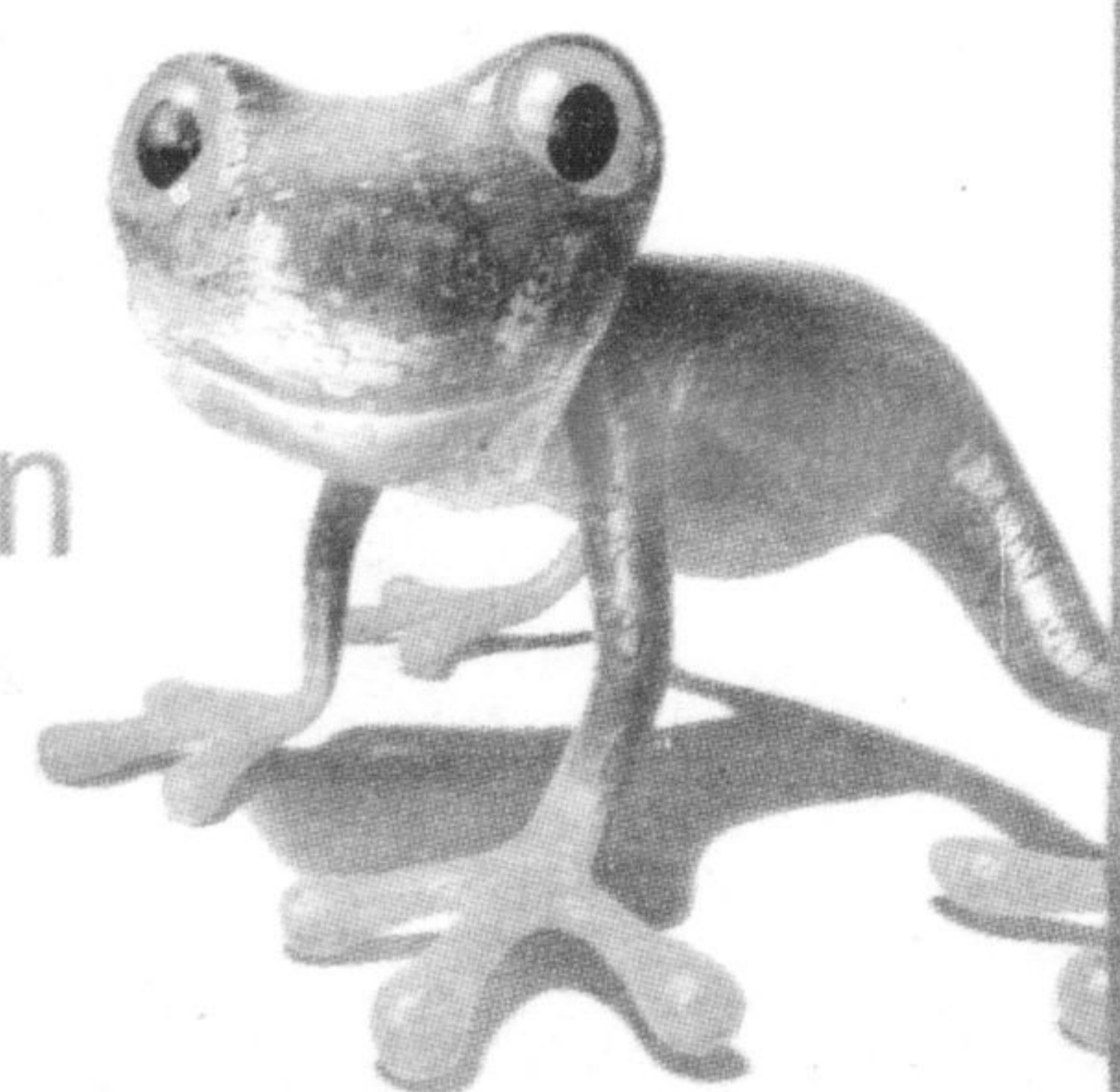
Ryder was a winner in the December 13 Daily Keno draw, playing a \$2 10-pick. She bought her ticket at Mac's on Bronte Street South.

Tetra Pak containers are recycled in Halton Region's Blue Box!



Tetra Pak containers are taken to paper mills where the cardboard is separated from the plastic and aluminum in a pulper – which is like a big blender!

Paper fibres from Tetra Pak cartons are used to make products like household tissue and boxes. Most often, the plastic and the aluminum is combined together to make things like sand pails.

Remember, Tetra Pak wine containers can be taken back to The Beer Store for a deposit.
