

Pathfinders to hold clothing, bottle drives this Saturday

At a time of year when the spirit of giving is alive and well, the 1st Campbellville Pathfinder Girl Guides are looking to help out homeless youth in Halton.

The girls are planning a used warm clothing drive this Saturday

and are hoping to collect at least 100 articles of clothing and footwear — a number that reflects the Girl Guides' 100th year in Canada.

"This warm clothing drive is something we really want to do for

local youth and parallels a similar community initiative we would like to do when we travel west next summer," said Toni Ritchie, guider with the 1st Campbellville Pathfinders.

Pathfinder Julia Field empha-

sized that even a country as fortunate as Canada has large numbers of people living on the streets who need help.

"Whether a friend or a homeless child, everyone needs some help," she said. "So this is our duty, and

it's a very important one."

On the same day, the girls will also be doing a bottle drive, with proceeds going toward their 'Quest To Go West' trip this July. The girls will be travelling to western Canada where they will take in sights and also dedicate a significant amount of time to community service.

Those interested in contributing warm clothing or bottles and who live in the Campbellville, Moffat and Brookville area (framed by Milborough Line, Derry Road, No. 15 Sideroad and Fourth Line) are asked to leave their donations at the road by 9 a.m. Saturday.

Pick-ups can also be arranged by appointment that day for residents living south of Derry Road or in urban Milton by calling (905) 854-4644.

Donations should be marked for the 1st Campbellville Pathfinder Girl Guides.

Tree pick-up to start soon

It will begin to look a lot like Christmas again as the decorated trees found in many homes throughout the region will soon adorn front lawns.

Halton Region will pick up natural Christmas trees from urban households during the next two regular collection days, beginning next week.

Having served their purpose, the firs, pines and spruces will be taken to Halton's waste management site in Milton where they will be turned into mulch for use in landscaping projects.

The Region collected 343 tonnes of trees in 2008, less than the 411 tonnes collected in 2007 and 347 in 2006.

The Region is reminding residents to remove all decorations from the trees, as well as plastic bags and tree stands, and to ensure the trees don't become stuck or frozen in snow banks.
