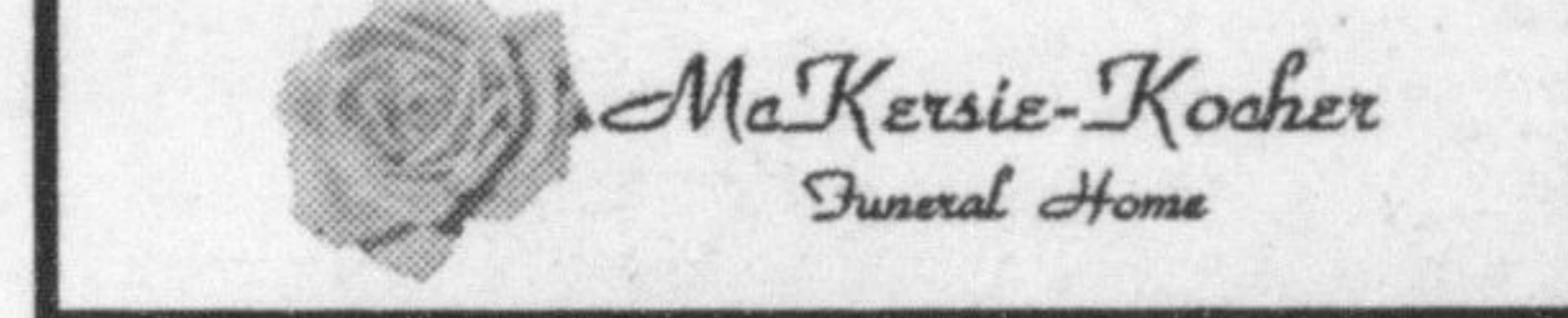


Obituaries

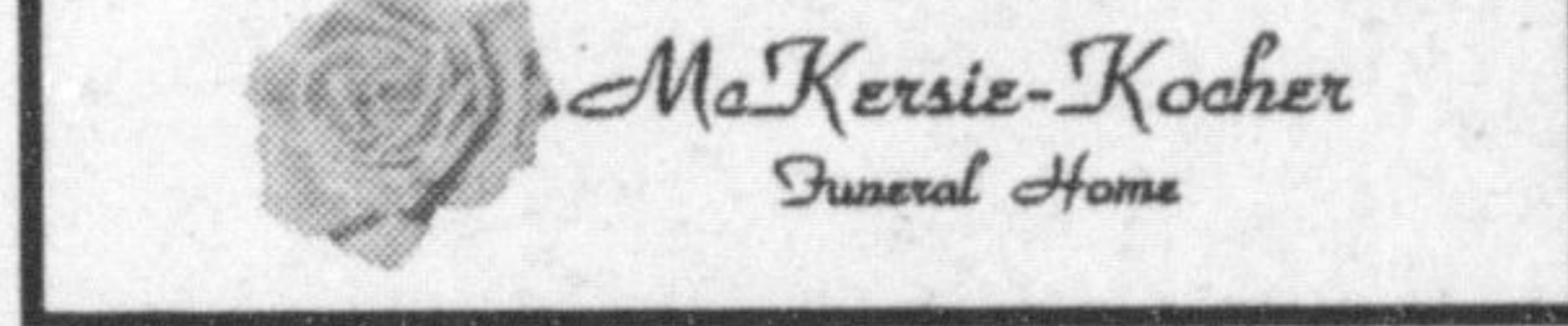
