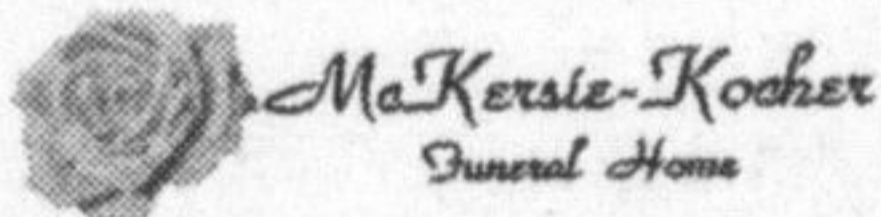

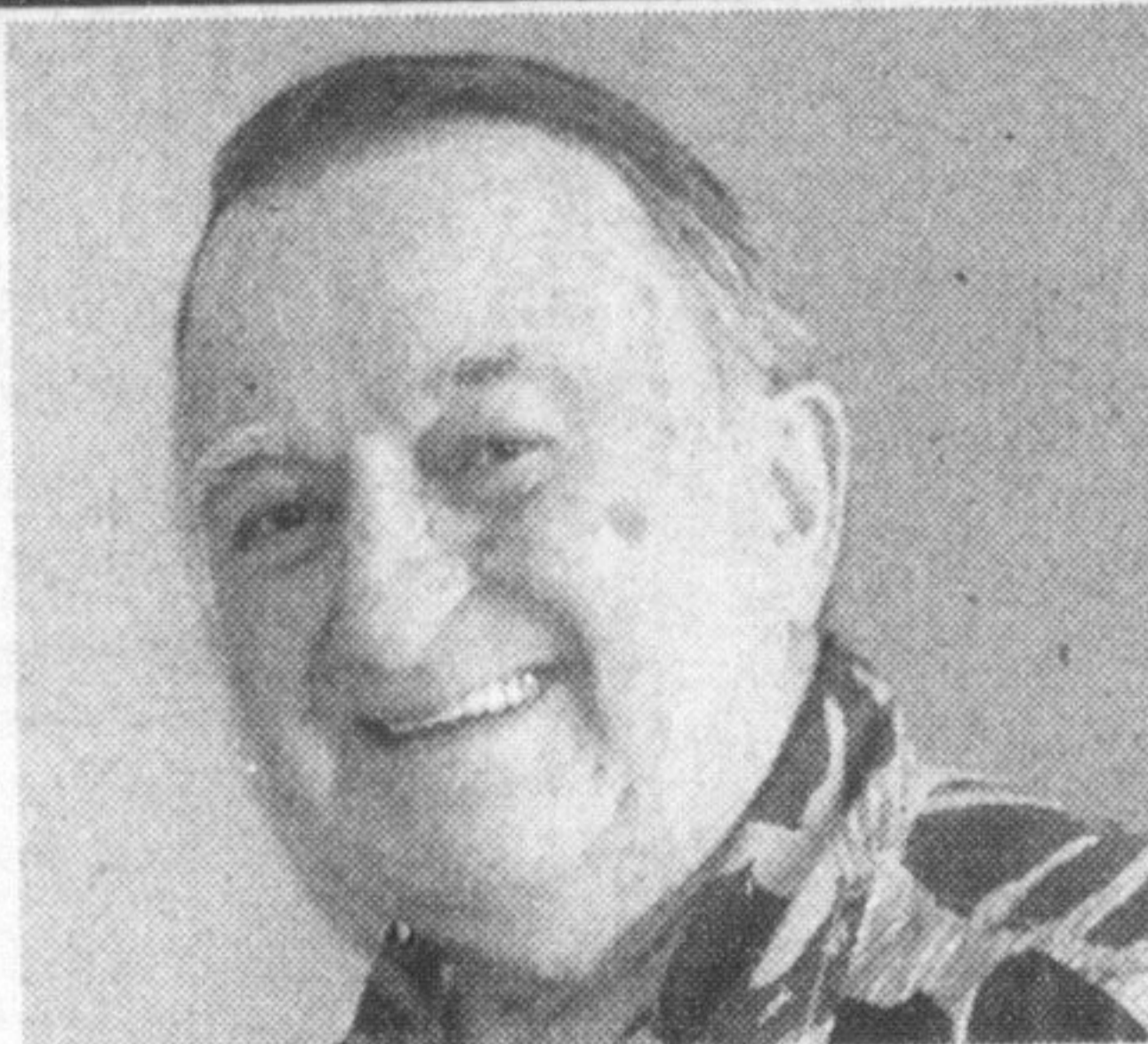

Survived by his sister Irma (Coady) Marsh of Glace Bay, NS and many nieces and nephews. Predeceased by his brothers; Elroy, Lawrence, Ralph, Ivan and sisters; Helen Watson, Leta Basso, Phyllis Lynk and Grace Melanson. 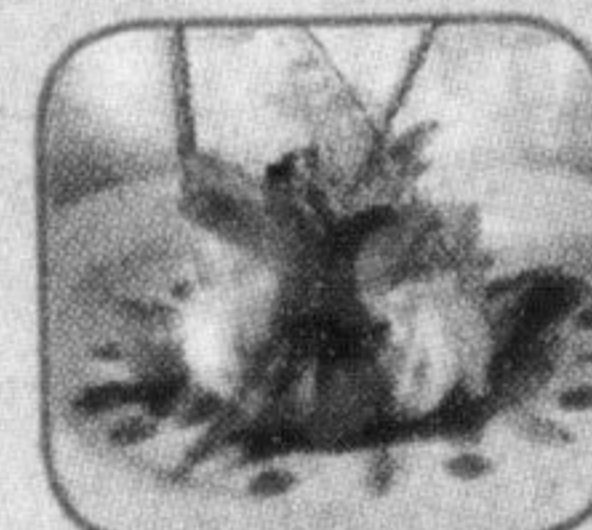

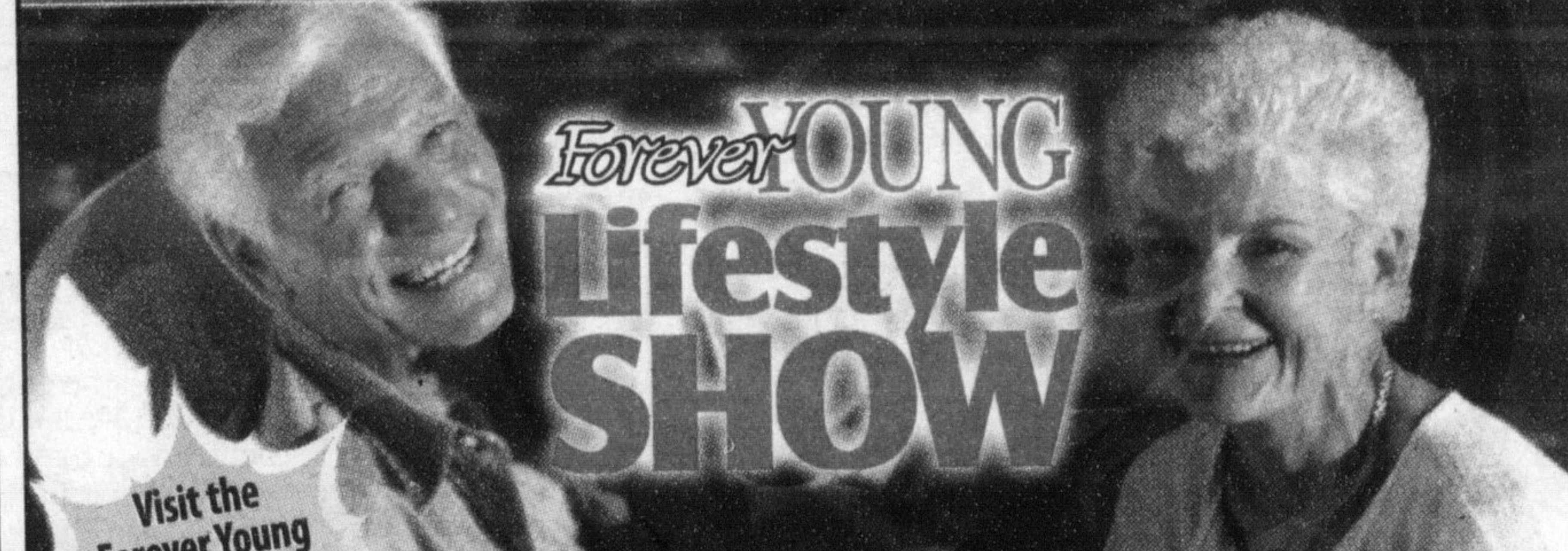

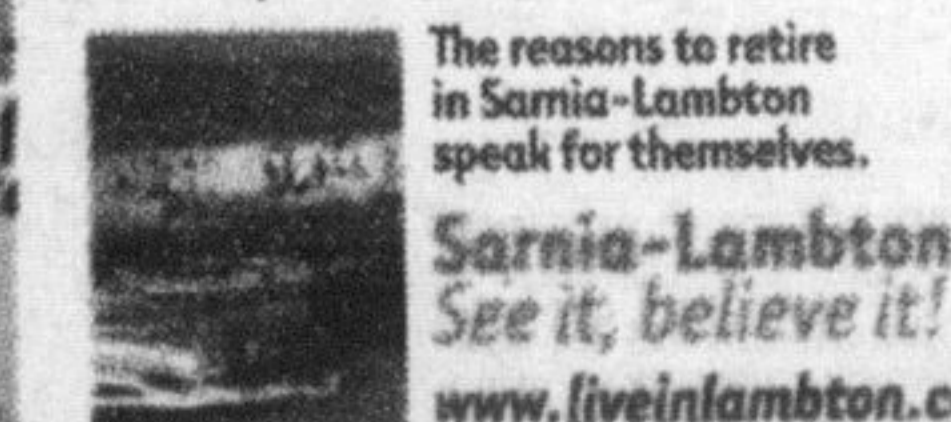
