



HOLOCAUST TRIBUTE: Milton District High School principal Ian Jones joins with his students in lighting memorial candles during the recent 2010 National Holocaust Memorial Ceremony at Ottawa's War Museum. The local school joined with students from a number of other schools, as well as an array of government ministers, national party leaders, senators and ambassadors from 35 countries, for the ceremony, which was organized by the Canadian Society for Yad Vashem on behalf of the Zachor Coalition. In its continuing efforts to remember and honour those who died in the Holocaust, Milton District has undertaken 'The Penny Project.' The aim is to collect one penny for each person lost in the Holocaust, with hundreds of thousands of pennies — by no means meant to be equated with the priceless value of those killed — having already been collected in a glass display case in the school foyer. The project will culminate with a two-day Holocaust conference in November.
