

Country Heritage Olde Tyme Faire coming up May 29

Event filled with non-stop interactive activities for children of all ages, says park manager

Families will find plenty of interactive activities with an old-fashioned flavour at the upcoming Country Heritage Olde Tyme Faire.

The event will take place Saturday, May 29 at Country Heritage Park, 8560 Tremaine Rd., from noon to 5 p.m.

"This is a fair with a difference," said park general manager David Nattress. "It's not a spectator fair. It's a fair filled with non-stop

interactive activities for children of all ages. It's about getting down and dirty on the farm."

It'll kick off at noon with the roar of lawn tractors pulling sleds with members of area 4-H lawn tractor pulling clubs at the wheel. They'll compete all afternoon in preparation for the "big pull" scheduled for July 16, 17 and 18 at the All Colour Antique Tractor and Toy Show.

There are two events kids aged 12 and under can compete in. There's the "pioneer dog show," in which kids bring their dogs dressed in their best costumes depicting pioneer days (mid-1800s). There's no cost to enter, and prizes will be awarded to all entrants. The winner will receive a grand prize. Registration starts at 1 p.m.

Kids who don't have a dog can dress up themselves and enter the pioneer fashion show, with judging based on authenticity. Registration starts at 1:30 p.m. All entrants will receive a prize.

In the games area, kids will be able to ride

the animal train, drive pedal harness horses, ride wooden animals, pitch bean bags and more.

A scavenger hunt will also take place.

At the Riley barn, families can visit live animals including sheep, miniature horses and draft horses.

And refreshments will be offered at "olde-tyme" prices.

Admission costs \$7 for adults, \$6 for seniors and \$4 for children. Kids under five are free and a family pass is available for \$20.

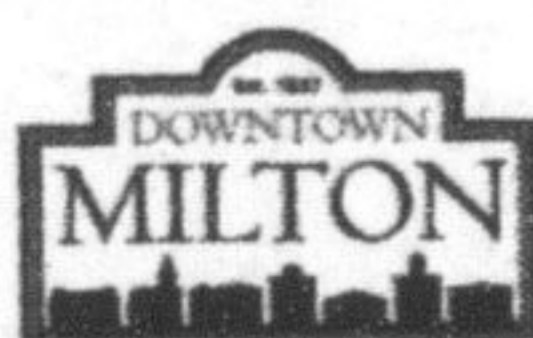

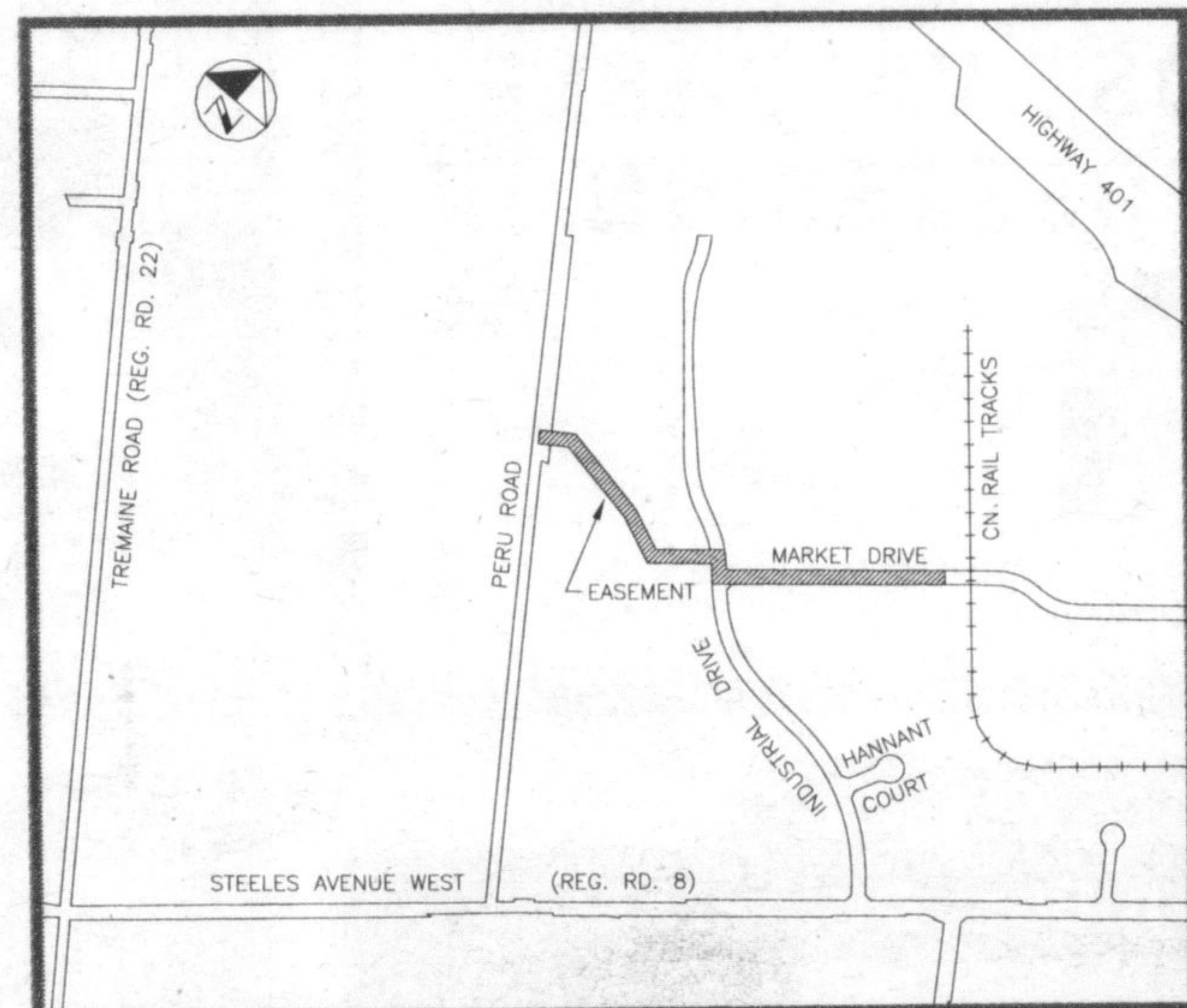
