up, and from there converted a rebound off a corner kick in the 71st minute.

“Cordell went out with precise instructions and performed fantastically, changing the course of the game with his speed, good technique and positioning,” said head coach Rafael Carbajal, who also credited conditioning coach Paolo Pacione with getting his team at peak fitness level this season. “One thing I try to do is keep the players on the

bench hungry enough that when they get the chance to go in they’ll give it their all.”

While Benjamin was clearly the hero of the night, MFC’s latest triumph was far from a one-man show.

In an effort to combat the Shooters’ vast experience and physicality, Carbajal made some key adjustments for the big showdown — which paid sizable dividends.

That was especially true with regard to Jason Morgan, who despite giving up a lot of

size to most of his opponents was a constant nuisance to the Shooters — winning countless battles in the midfield throughout the second half.

Combine that with some effective head-play by 18-year-old Chris Suta — moved up from defence — and the visitors’ attack was neutralized before it even started.

Also showing his versatility was Tristan Scott, who dropped back to provide some added speed and mobility on defence.

“Good teams need those interchangeable parts. That’s been big for us,” said Rossi.

Perhaps a bit too confident after a sweep the previous weekend, MFC lacked spark

through the early going and fell behind at the 36-minute mark, with York super-striker Kadian Lecky netting his seventh of the year.
