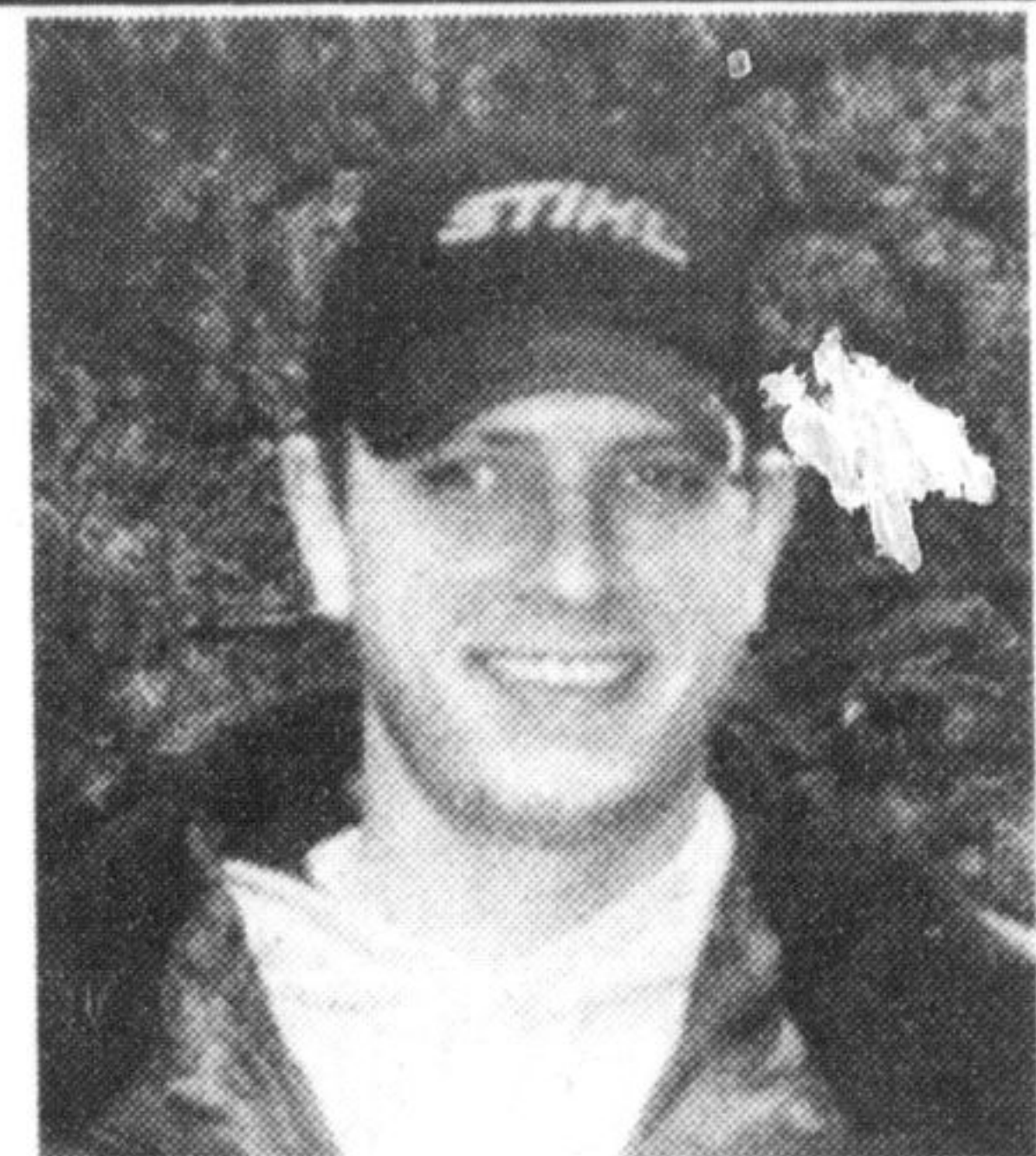

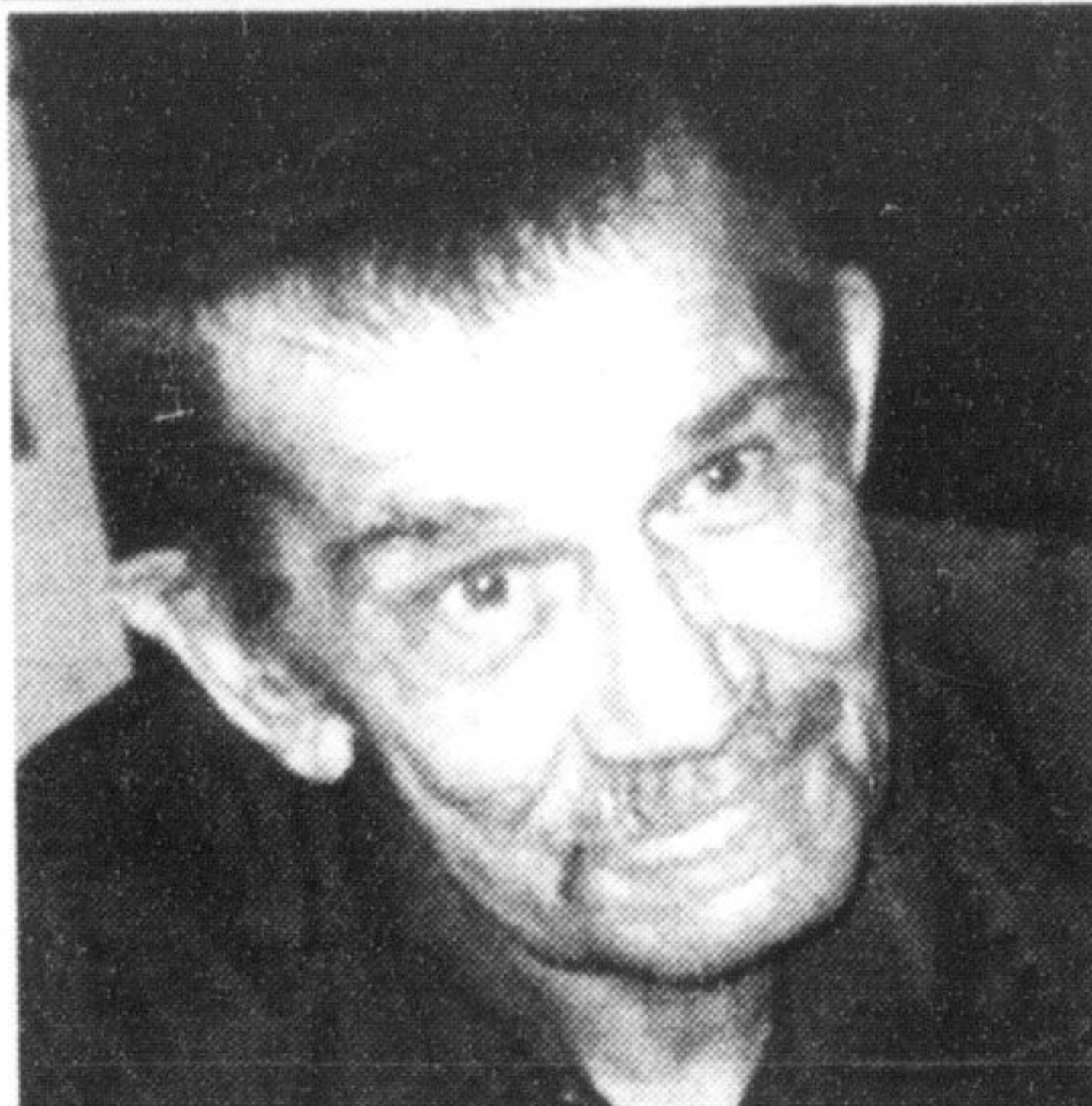


WILSON, Ronald - Veteran of WWII, Royal Signals 23rd Section
