

# Two men attacked by group of teens on Bell Street

Police are looking for a group of teens in connection with an altercation on Bell Street last Thursday night.

Two Milton men — aged 29 and 31 — were walking along Bell when they came upon five teens, four males and a female.

Heated words were exchanged and a confrontation ensued, during which the younger man was punched and kicked repeatedly by four of the teens while the older

man was held back and struck with a lacrosse stick by the other teen.

The younger man was wrestled to the ground and choked, almost to the point of unconsciousness, before the youths fled the scene. He was taken to Milton District Hospital with swelling around the eyes and bruises to the head and upper body.

The other man didn't sustain serious injury.

It's not known whether the vic-

tims or suspects knew each other before the incident.

One of the suspects is described as a white male, 16 to 17 years of age, of medium height and weight with short, almost shaved brown hair. The female teen is described as white, of average height and build with shoulder-length blond hair.

The other suspects are simply

described as white males between 17 and 19 years old.

### Man assaulted, robbed

Three young men are being sought following the assault and robbery of a man out walking his dog at Rotary Park early Tuesday morning.

Police report that at 5:20 a.m. the 31-year-old dog walker was approached by three men, who chased him a short distance before pushing him to the ground, assaulting him and taking his wallet and inhaler. The suspects were last seen headed through the bushes at the northwest corner of Rotary Park.

The victim was taken to Milton District Hospital and treated for back pain and cuts and bruises.

Halton Regional Police's canine unit was unable to locate the men, although the wallet (minus contents) and inhaler were found a short time later.

The suspects are described simply as two black males with shaved heads and one white male with long brown hair.

### Impaired charges laid

A 59-year-old Milton man faces charges in connection with an incident in town this past weekend.

Police were notified of a vehicle being driven erratically while coming off Hwy. 401 at about 10:30 p.m. Saturday. Upon investigation and stopping a car on Pettigrew Trail, the driver was charged with impaired driving and 'over 80.'

### GPS unit stolen

A GPS unit was taken from an unlocked vehicle on LeSage Crescent overnight Monday. The unit was valued at roughly \$500.

### Vehicles broken into

Two vehicles were broken into overnight Friday.

A wallet with ID was stolen from a pick-up truck on Barclay Circle, while loose change was taken from an undisclosed vehicle on Vanier Drive.

It's not known whether the vehicles were locked.

## Stolen car found abandoned, out of gas

Halton Regional Police are investigating a vehicle theft.

On the morning of June 18, an employee of a local business discovered that a work vehicle had been stolen from the area of Derry Road and Fourth Line. The vehicle was an older model dark blue Honda Accord.

On June 20, the vehicle was located abandoned in



the area of Steeles Avenue and Tenth Line; the vehicle was out of gas.

## Attempted murder suspect returns to court today

A Milton man charged with attempted murder in connection with the stabbing of a teen is scheduled to make a court appearance today.

Charles Canavan, 18, who's in custody after waiving his right to a bail hearing, will appear via video

link at Ontario Court of Justice in Milton.

The date was set at his most recent appearance June 24.

Just before 2 a.m. May 29, an 18-year-old Milton male was stabbed in the abdomen on Thompson Road, just south of

Childs Drive, during an altercation.

The suspect has also been charged with assault with a weapon, assault, possession of a dangerous weapon and breach of recognizance in connection with two separate altercations in the area just prior to the stabbing.

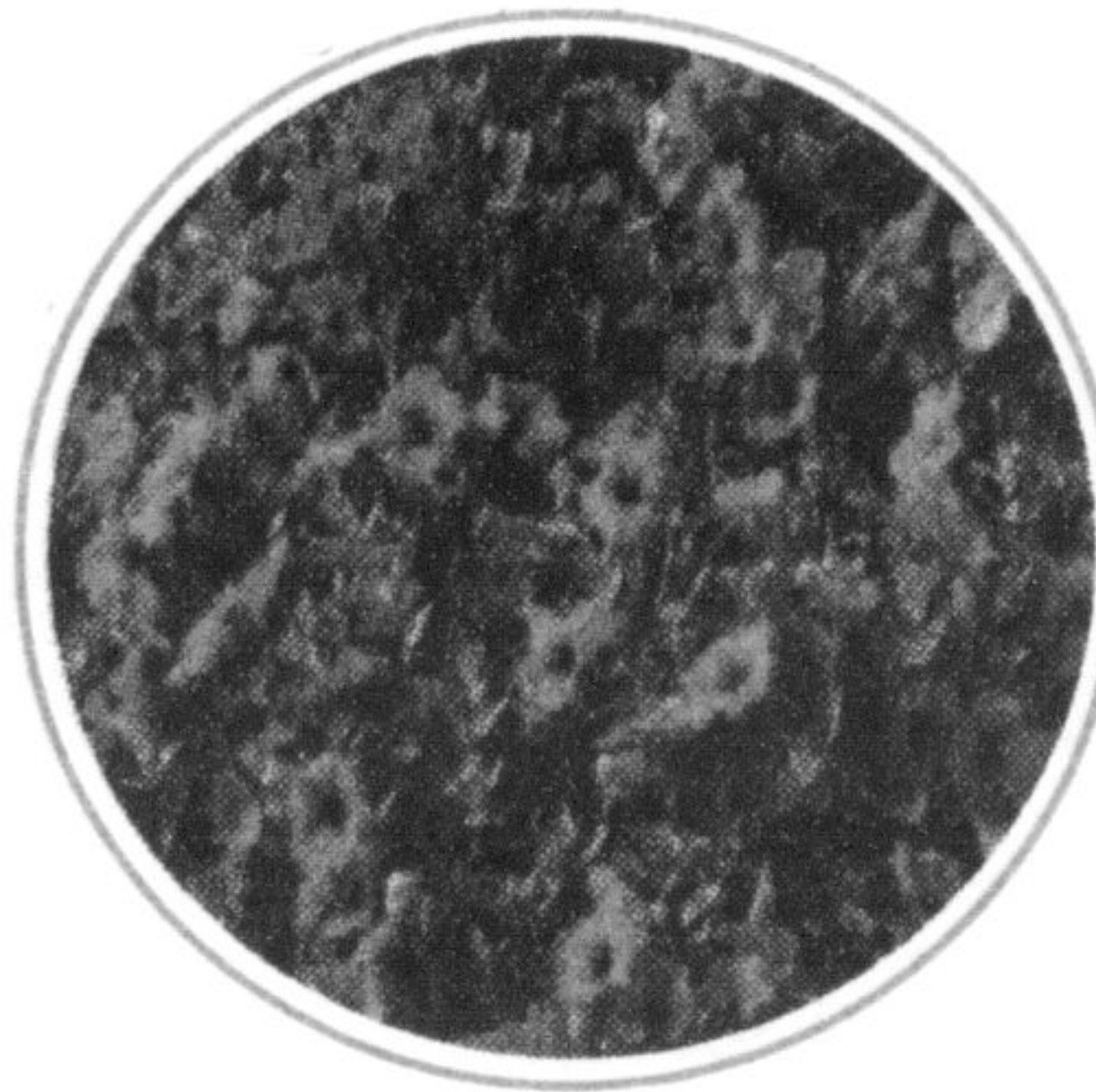

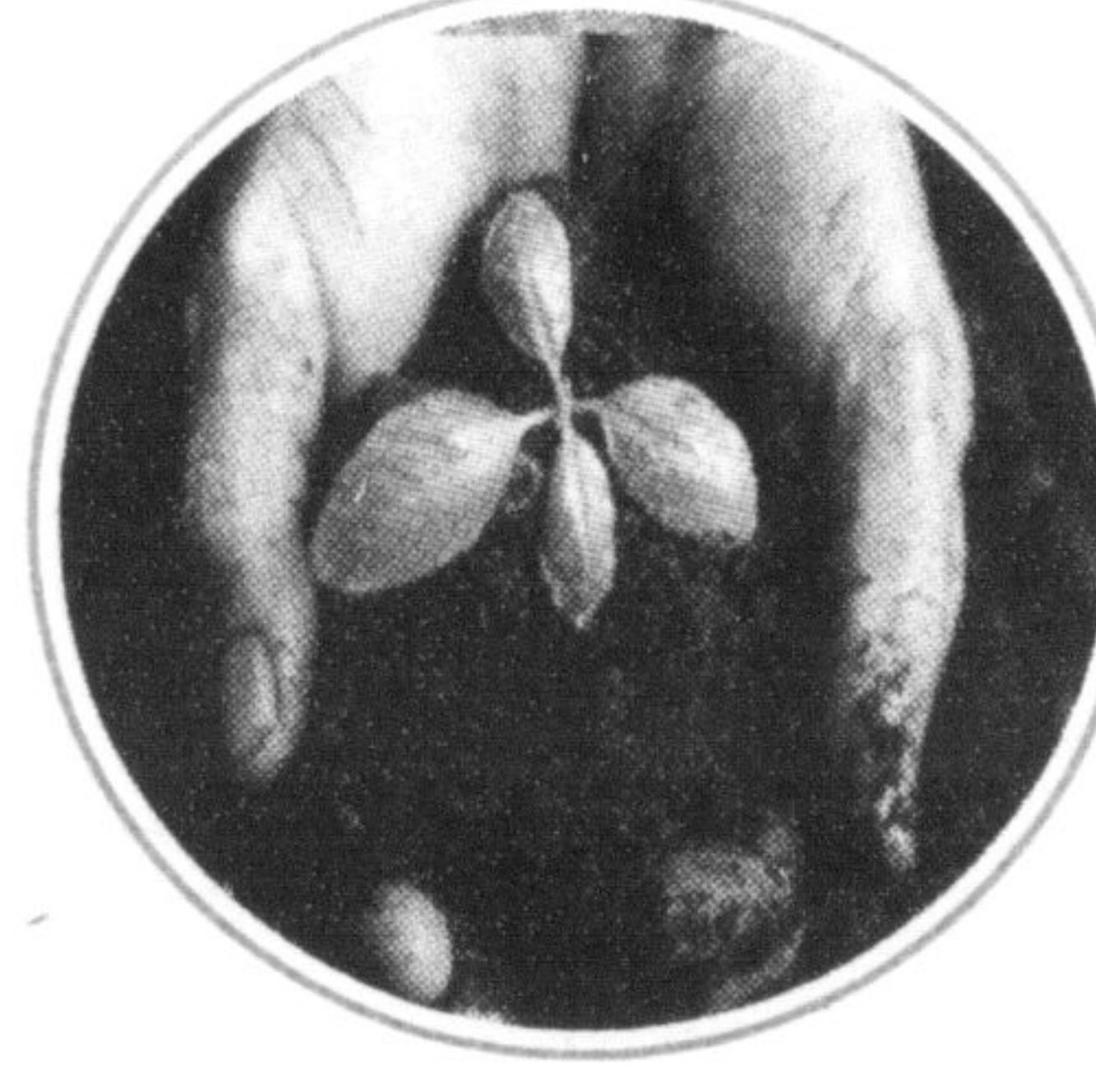
