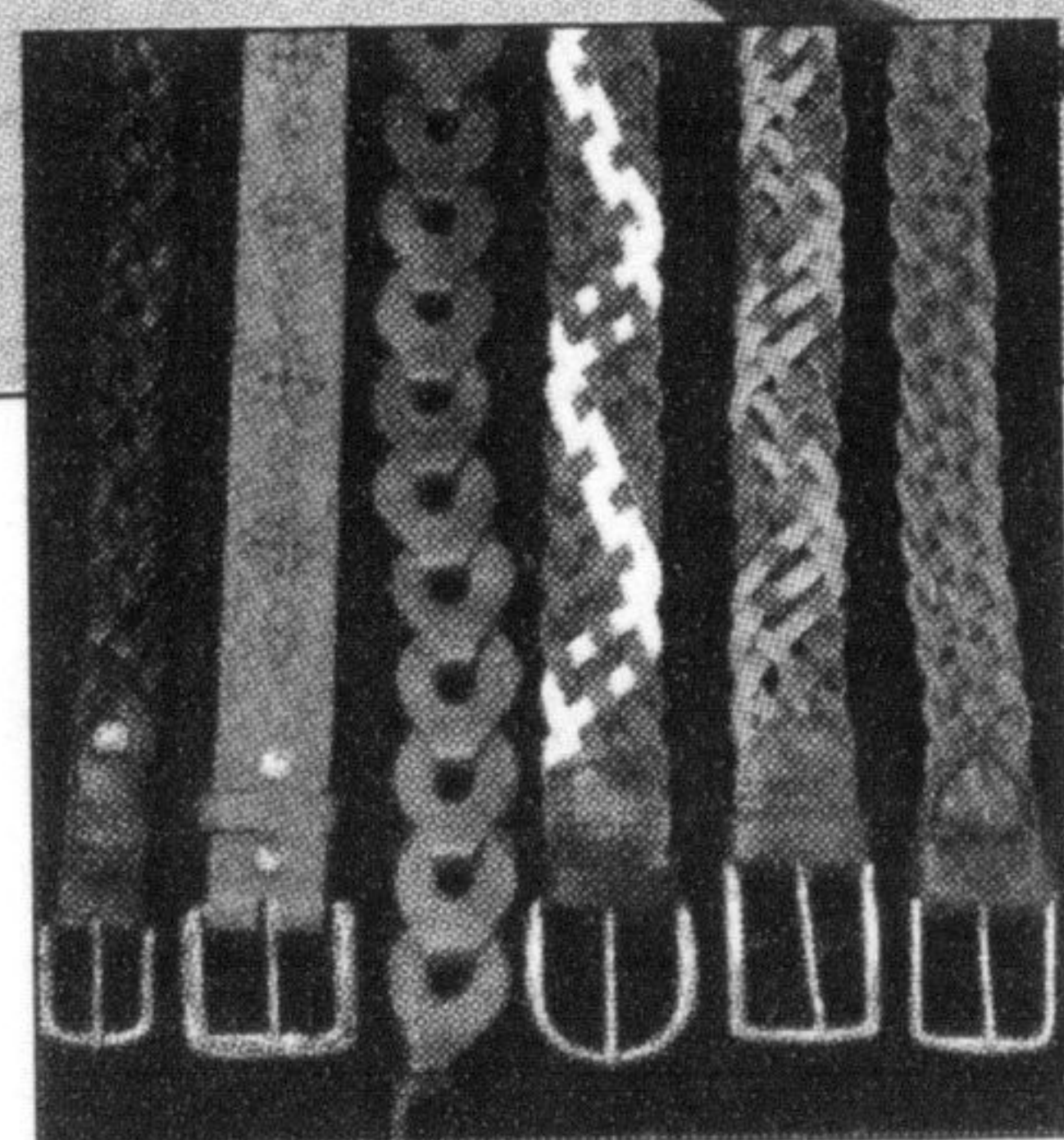


See what's new at the A.M. Gallery
