# IceHawks set to renew old rivalries in re-aligned West

The IceHawks will have no shortage of new opponents — including two returning ones — when they head into 2010/11 play next month.

Reduced to 31 teams and undergoing yet another realignment, the Ontario Junior Hockey League will see Milton renew old rivalries with Burlington and Hamilton in the West Division.

Making up the rest of the loop are the usual suspects, including Georgetown, Brampton, Buffalo, Mississauga and Oakville.

Now just a few days away from the start of training camp, the IceHawks have made a number of key player moves this summer.

Owner's son Adam Pielt and veteran Justin Pereira have opted to continue their junior careers out west in the British Columbia Hockey League, while hometown offensive standout James Woodcroft, 20, is back from his second call-up with the two-time Memorial Cup champion Windsor Spitfires.

Milton looks to be significantly older this coming season, if early pick-ups are any indication.

Acquired from the now defunct Bramalea Blues, 20-year-old forward Peter Raineri should help shoulder some of the scoring

load — having tallied 19 goals and 33 assists last year.

On the defensive side of things, the local juniors have picked up a couple of 19-year-old veterans of the Greater Ontario Jr. B ranks.

Coming over from the Elmira Sugar Kings, Brandon Gorecki backstopped his way to a 3.41 goals-against average and a .902 save percentage in 30 games last year, while six-foot-two-inch, 170-pound Coulter Cahill is a solid stay-at-home blueliner from the Strathroy Rockets.

Looking to rebound from a dismal 3-51-1-1 season, the IceHawks will play a 50-game schedule this year and will be quite busy from the onset — with five games in the first nine days.

This hectic stretch begins with a trip to Markham Friday, Sept. 10, followed by a Sunday, Sept. 12 afternoon game (3 p.m. start) versus Huntsville.

Markham and Huntsville are part of the North Division, in which the IceHawks will have interlocking games against.

Led by returning head coach/general manager Mike Rusk, Milton begins training this coming weekend, with its first home-ice exhibition contest set for Saturday, Aug. 28 at 3:30 p.m. with Orangeville.
