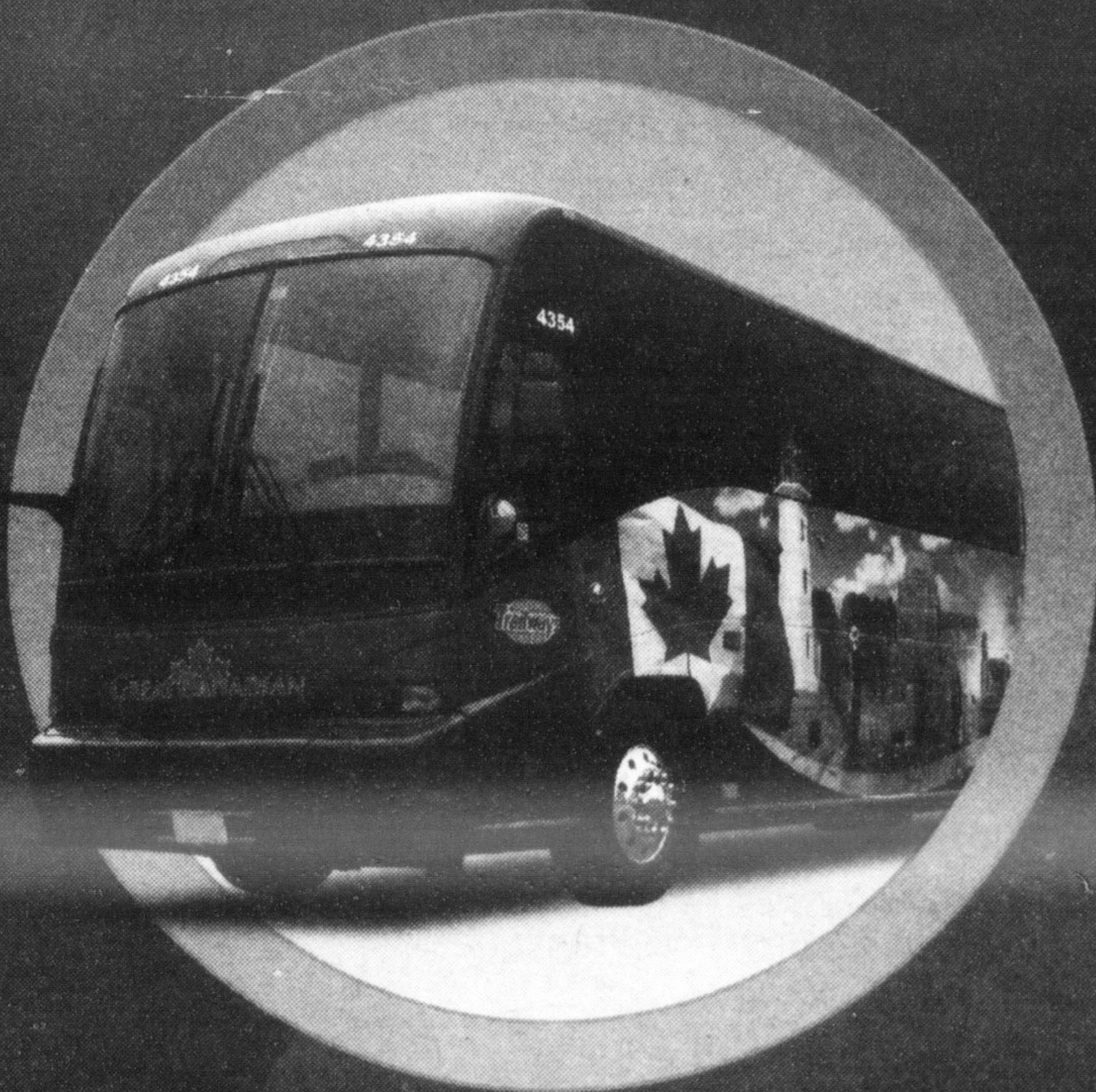

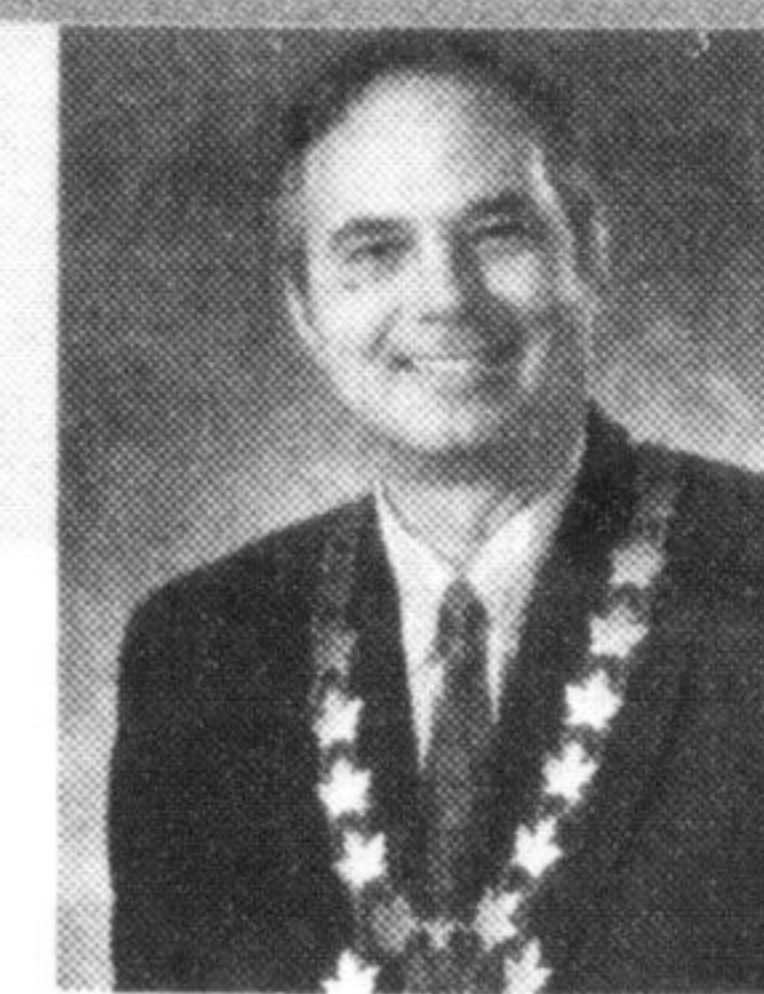
Communicating Building a Better Halton
