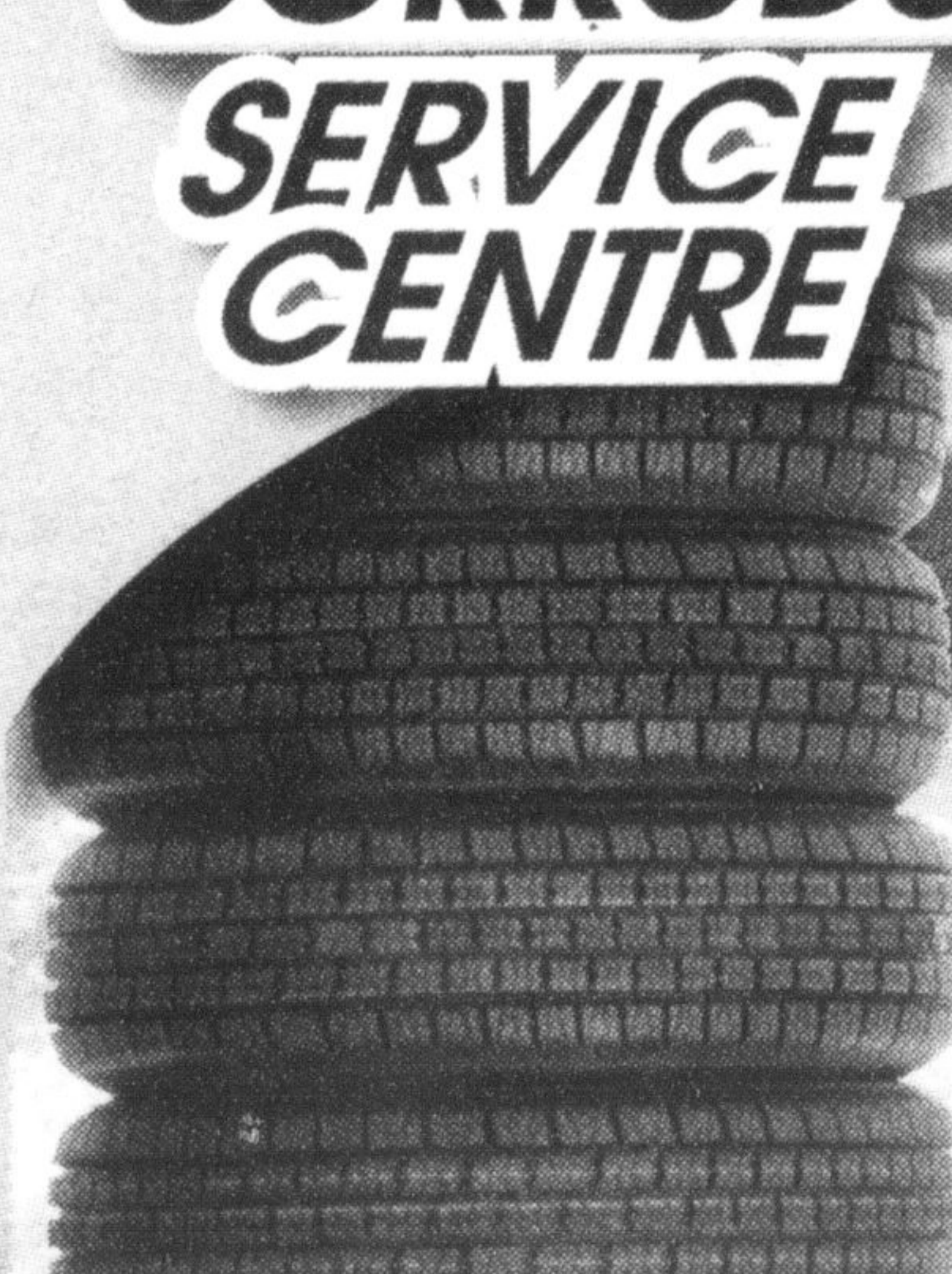

Voting up a bit

Well, at least they were better — barely — than last time.

Of the 48,042 Miltonians eligible to vote in this fall's municipal election, just 32.64 per cent — or 15,683 — exercised that right at the polls.

This represents exactly a 2.5 per cent increase over 2006.

For the most part, voter turnout was strongest in the older parts of town. Ward 2's downtown core drew the highest numbers, with one poll at 38.05 per cent.

The newer areas of Milton generally fell between 22 and 25 per cent turnout. The lowest turnout — 18 per cent — came in a Ward 5 poll.

Acclaimed Ward 3 Councillor Cindy Lunau said she was disappointed with the voter turnout.

"With the tight races, I expected we might see at least closer to a 40 per cent turnout, but that didn't seem to materialize," she said. "I worry about Canadians as a whole becoming complacent about the vote. It's bizarre, we celebrate a 50 per cent voter turnout in Afghanistan, and we can't even begin to approach it here."

She continued, "Certainly the candidates worked hard to get voters out, certainly there was no doubt there was an election going on. But how do you tell people that this is perhaps the most important hour you spend every four years?"

Advanced polls drew 1,875 Miltonians, representing roughly 12 per cent of all those who cast a ballot. The number was up from the 2006 election.

"We wanted to provide the voters with as many options as possible to vote," said Town Clerk Troy McHarg. "There were some skeptics about the holiday Monday poll, but it was our second highest daily turnout at Hugh Foster Hall."

This year also saw the number of days of advanced polling rise from six to eight, and an additional polling station was added.
