

School bus driver acted responsibly, police find

A Halton Regional Police investigation has determined a school bus driver acted appropriately in an October 27 railway crossing incident that Bishop Reding Secondary School students have stated left them horrified.

In a press release earlier this week, Halton police said investigators interviewed many witnesses including the driver and have concluded the driver acted "responsibly, professionally and with the interest of his passengers foremost in his mind."

Police said their investigation into the incident revealed the school bus in question stopped as required before the crossing arms at the Main Street CP tracks, just east of Ontario

Police said the driver listened and looked for any train traffic, and when there was no indication a train was coming, he began to cross the tracks.

The driver had just started to move the bus forward, police said, when the signals began to alert the arrival of a service train. The driver immediately stopped the bus. The crossing arms came down and contacted the bus near the back half.

Police said the driver, worried that traffic behind the bus wouldn't be able to see the crossing arms, pulled forward to a point where the arms fell behind the bus.

A CP Rail employee with 22 years of experience, who was at the scene, confirmed the bus was several metres away from the service tracks and at no time was anyone in danger, police said.

It was in question whether nearby workmen changed the direction of the train at the last minute to
