

IceHawks let lead slip away, fall 4-3 to Georgetown

A productive start and strong goaltending weren't quite enough for the Milton IceHawks Saturday.

Unable to build on 1-0 and 3-1 leads established in the first 10 minutes of play, Milton was nipped 4-3 by the second-place Georgetown Raiders — and fell to 3-27 in Ontario Junior Hockey League play in the process.

Making his season debut, Ryan Lenardon turned back 34 shots to keep the IceHawks in a position to upset their neighbouring rivals throughout the night.

Lester Brown had a goal and an assist, while Justin Periera had two helpers and Spencer Gourlay and Jordan Scaglione were the other marksmen.

Georgetown rallied with three un-

answered goals in the second period and nursed its narrow lead down the stretch.

At Memorial Arena Friday, the IceHawks had another tough second period and were downed 6-1 by the North Division-leading Markham Waxers.

Tyler Badham erased a 1-0 deficit early in the middle frame, but the formidable visitors quickly restored the upper hand — even with a quiet night from their offensive anchor, Behn Robertson.

Still languishing in the West Division basement, Milton is back at home Friday to take on the Brampton Capitals, starting at 7:30 p.m.

This will mark their first meeting with Brampton since trading away hometown sniper James Woodcroft, who turned in his seventh and eighth straight multi-point games this past weekend and continues to sit atop the league scoring race with 70 points (36g, 34a).
