The Holcim Gallery includes about 1,100 square-feet of space featuring flexible hanging systems

and moveable walls to accommodate individual and group art exhibitions.

New manger of the centre, Rob Mackay, said he envisions the facility as "a provider of a richer and complete community." He said local artists will be featured in the gallery for three-week intervals.

The residential campaign 'Put Your Heart in the Arts' is also well underway with individuals, fami-

lies, community and arts groups donating by buying piano keys for the theatre's grand piano, purchasing theatre seats, staging school or neighbourhood fundraisers and through financial donations.
