In all there were permits for 95 single family homes, 33 renovations for single family homes and 43 townhouses.

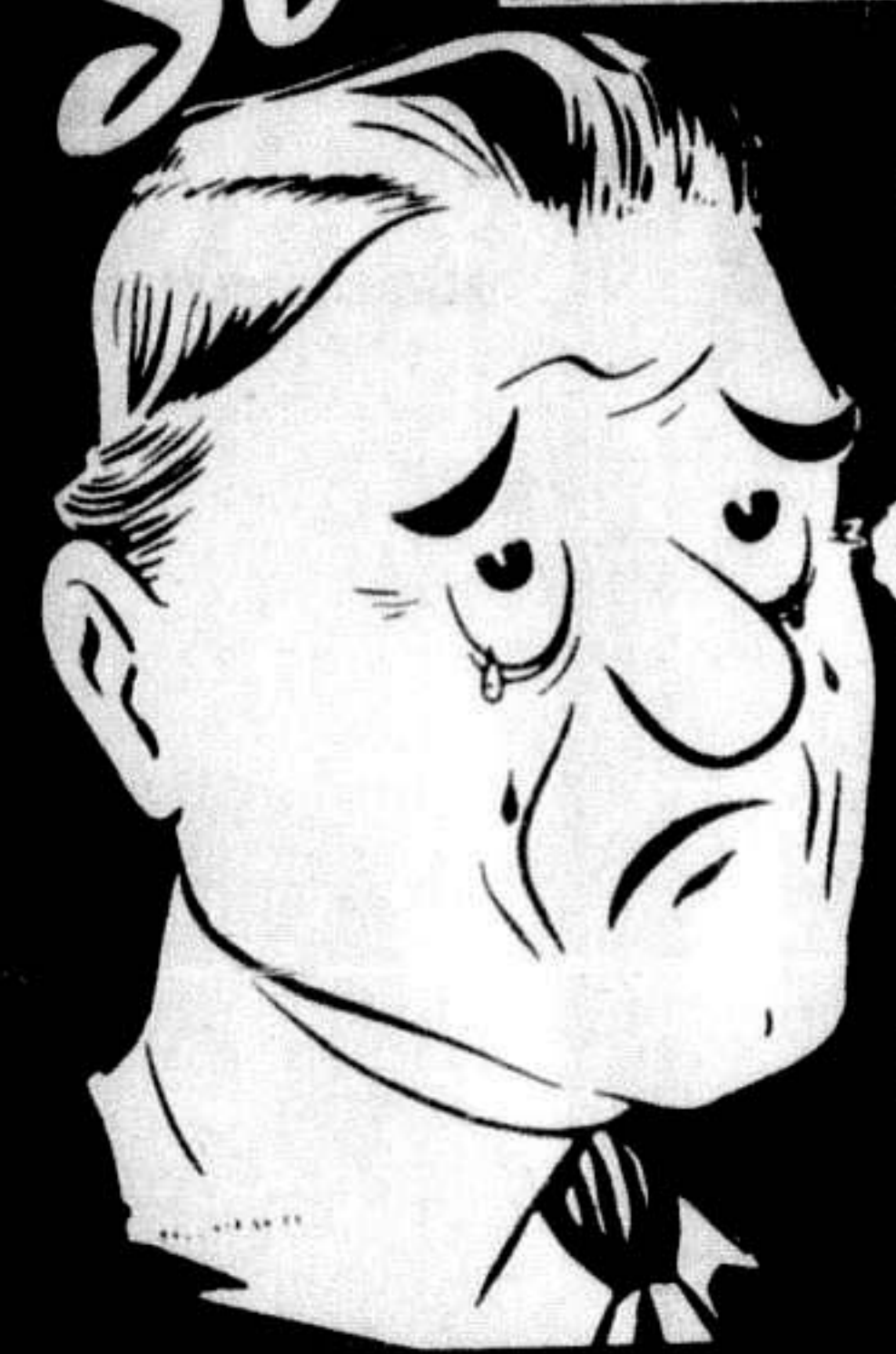
Other major permits issued during the month included a permit for Milton Plaza at \$2,500,000 and a permit for office additions taken out by John Wannamaker for \$140,000.
