Editor's Desk

A lot of the research we newspaper people do for our stories is downright tedious and often boring. But one research assignment I recently undertook—tracing the involvement of a local dentist Dr. J. B. Willmott with the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario—was a very enjoyable task.

Lyndon Smith, of Meadowbrook Drive, Milton, first tipped me off about Dr. Willmott's involvement as the first dean of the college and provided a magazine and a book which facilitated the research. Then a check with local resident Joe Willmott, Maplewood Cresc., filled me in on his connection with the local Willmott family (which, incidentally, has been around Milton for 150 years. At one point the Willmott family farmed 400 acres of land south of Derry Rd.)

You'll find the story of Dr. Willmott elsewhere in today's

issue. Don't miss reading it—Dr. Willmott was a colorful character in the history of Milton and in the field of dentistry and it was a pleasure to help record it, for posterity.

The story doesn't mention the climate of dentistry in the late 1800s, which I found interesting but not really necessary to the Willmott story. Quackery and blatant dental advertising marked the day. According to one source, "unscrupulous tramp dentists roamed the countryside and gunsmiths often practiced dentistry as a sideline."

Prices of work in those days were revealing, too. It cost 25 cents for a filling, 10 cents for pulling a tooth. Don't try comparing those rates with today's as you must remember this was at the time Timothy Eaton's store in Toronto was selling a spool of thread for a penny and men's neckties for five cents!

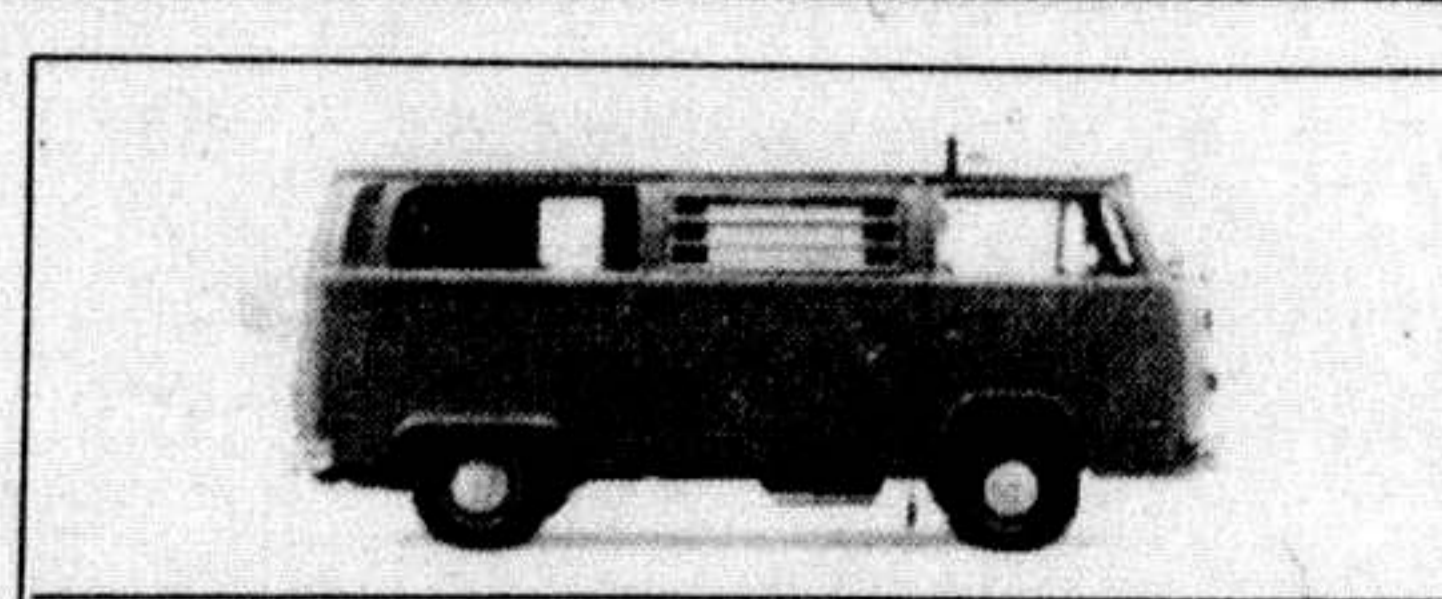
