ings. HWP officially opened Oct. 20 as a home for abused and battered women and their families. It was the first such home set up in Halton with clients using the home funded by a regional purchase of service agreement.

But HWP asked if it could expand its mandate to take in women who, while not the victim of physical abuse, needed a place to go or had no shelter.

Mr. Vivian suggested it would be better for the region to spend the money at HWP and help it meet a \$20,000 shortfall in funding, than spend it on a motel room.

Burlington Councillor Steve Toth, while he supported the idea at committee, said he did not want anyone to think Halton is a "soft touch."

At last week's regular council meeting, the recommendation to expand the purchase of service agreement to include "non-abused women and their dependent children if any in need of shelter" was approved without comment.
