Juno winner Eastman in concert

Eddie Eastman—Juno award winner as the top country male singer in Canada—is coming to town.
He and his band, "Terra Nova Express" will be headlining an outdoor stage show at Fifth Wheel Truck Stop, 40 Chisholm Dr., Milton on Tuesday, June 9.
The concert, primarily intended as a "thank-you gesture" for Fifth Wheel's best customers—the professional truck drivers—is free and open to the general public as well.
International Harvester truck dealers in this

area and Fifth Wheel are jointly sponsoring the concert. International plans to have a display of its new 1981 "big rigs" at the show.

The Eastman concerts, dubbed "Country Round-Up", will be taking place at four of Fifth Wheel's five truck stops that week. The travelling road show starts in Dorchester Monday, June 8; moves to Milton Tuesday, June 9; then to Bowmanville Wednesday, June 10 and ends in Cornwall Thursday, June 11.

Each day's format is the same. The Eastman concerts go on stage at 4.30 and 7 p.m. each day, and each concert will last at least one hour.

Appearing on stage will also be two female singers recruited from Fifth Wheel's own staff—waitress Sonya Vasotto of Milton, a pop singer; and fuel bar cashier Bernadette Van Loon of Cornwall unit, the young woman who composed and sings the company's own popular song, "Your Home is at Fifth Wheel."
Each stage show will also feature a fashion show of western wear, courtesy of Lee Jeans, A mobile country store will

be set up to sell western wear during each show.
The Round-Up also includes a beef barbecue plus daily draws for merchandise prizes. The barbecue, truck display and country store sale will run from 3 to 9 p.m. each day.

Jim Powers, Fifth Wheel's vice-president, explained the show is "an annual treat for the truckers, to show our appreciation for their business."
Each year Fifth Wheel organizes a summer barbecue for the pro drivers. Last year it was a pork barbecue, utilizing the company's own port-

able barbecue.
The company's pre-Christmas treat is a full course turkey dinner, usually staged simultaneously at each Fifth Wheel location. It's also free for truckers. Last year's Dec. 19 giveaway totalled 1,350 dinners, he said.

Fifth Wheel units have been distributing invitations to the pro drivers to attend Country Round-Up, since mid-May. "The beef barbecue is free for the truckers who hold tickets issued at the truck stops, the general public will pay \$2.50 (cost) for the meal," Mr. Powers said.

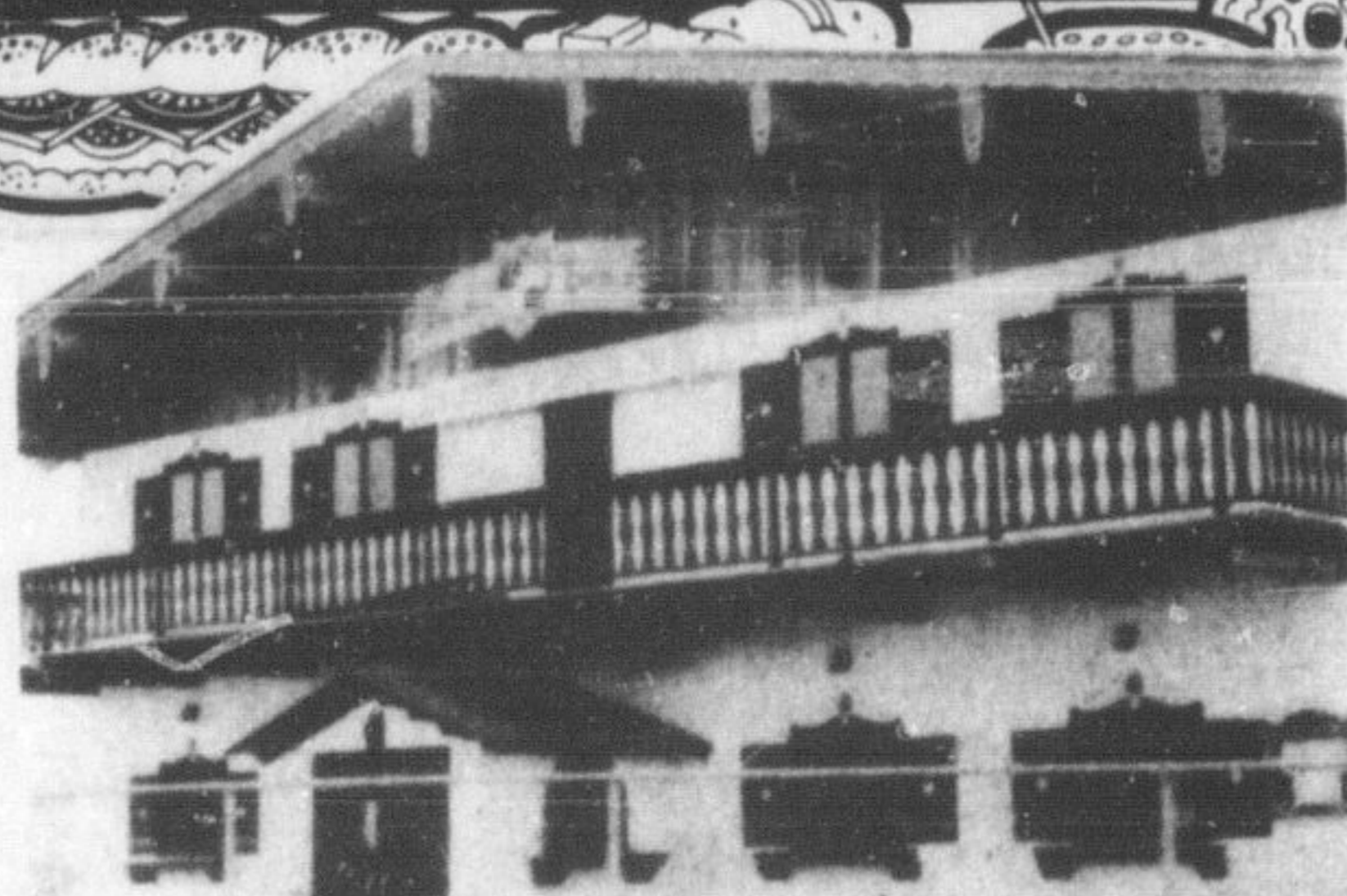
