Collector's display will feature guns, models, knives, and scrimshaw. Candles, woodwork, pottery, and paintings

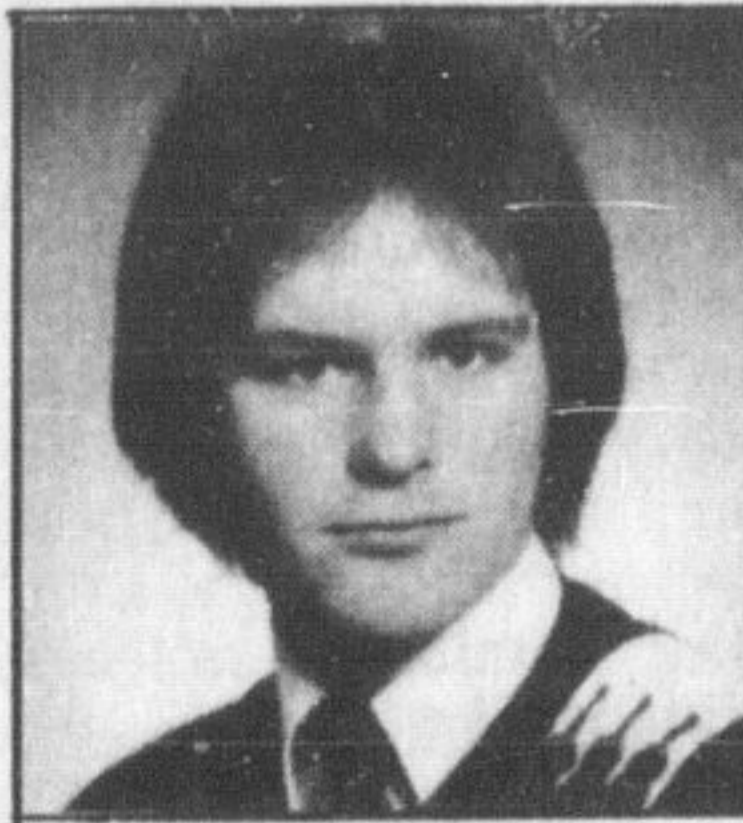
will be exhibited and be on sale. There will also be a white elephant sale.

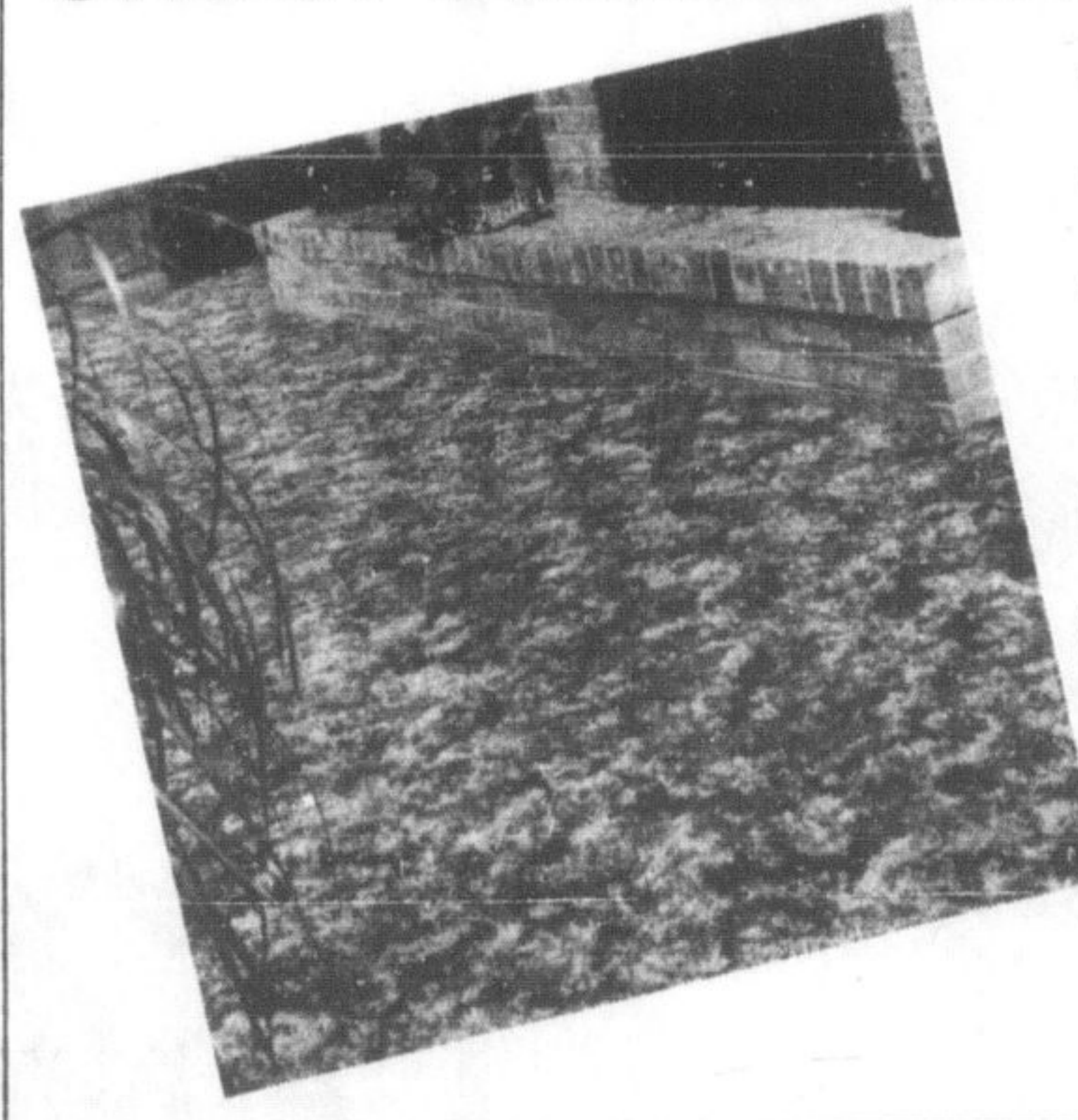

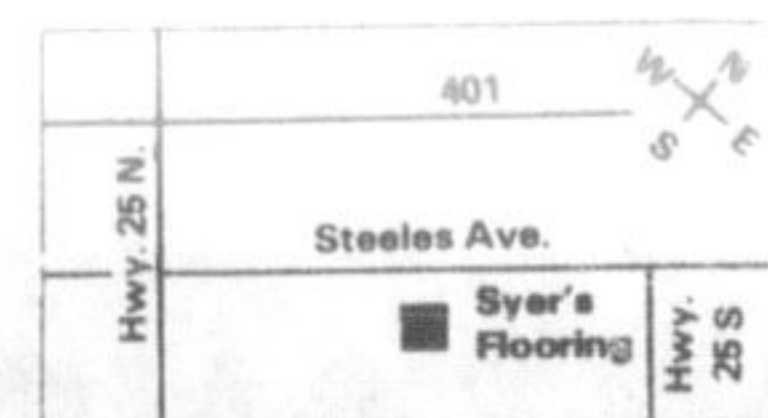

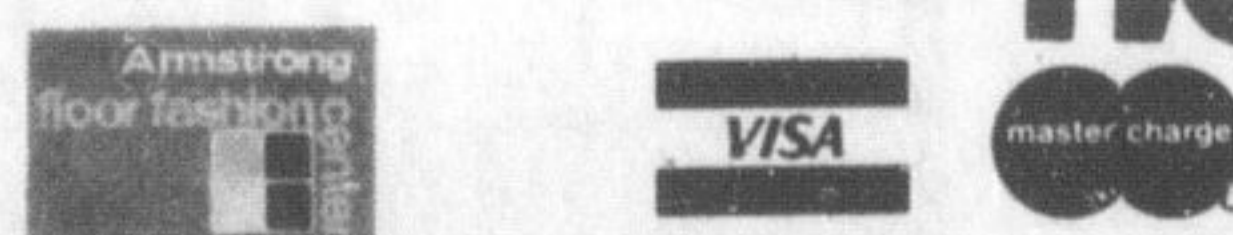
