



A Milton resident for almost 26 years, Mr. Richardson used to have his own television and appliance store on Main St. Today that has been sold to Campbell's Furniture at Ontario and Main St.

Aubrey is one of those people who knows how to sell merchandise in the friendly, confident manner which lets you know you are dealing with an honest man.

While selling, he was also doing a lot of repairing back in 1973 when he had a chance to take over the Laundereze in the Milton Mall.

Because he knows how these heavy machines work and what is involved in the rigorous maintenance, he bought it, cleaned the place up, brought in a series of new machines and set about creating a laundromat which is not only spotless, but it has an attendant who is there to handle any problems, and that's far better than a tag which says "out of order." And that brings us to the Mill St. Coin Laundry which used

to be in the building where the Dickens Restaurant now is. Aubrey took that over about three years ago but the ideals of cleanliness and the type of service he wanted to provide meant a move last year across the street and into a brand new building.

Of course that meant investing in the biggest and best machines. A front loader washing machine is not the garden variety at home. It costs more than \$2,000 and is designed to do the job right and many times per day. And then he added the touches which set his operation a cut

Aubrey believes strongly that there should always be an

attendant in the building. He says people might need change, might need soaps and bleaches, and yes, they might even need a little help folding

But it also helps alleviate the frustration caused by the "out of order" sign. Aubrey said that if a machine should go on the blink, the

attendant will telephone him and he'll be over in minutes to do the repairs. That way there aren't long lineups waiting for a few machines. Another touch is the "we'll do your laundry" service. For

only \$1 extra per load, the staff will do all the work while the clothing owner is off doing important errands in town. And there's still more.

You can't put everything in the washing machine, and that's way Aubrey has a dry cleaning depot in the Mill St. Coin Laundry. It offers return service, usually within 24 hours, and it

allows the customer to bring all his or her cleaning jobs to one location. No more running around town. Aubrey has the coin laundry on a large lot which offers all the free parking anyone would need, even if they bring in the

washing by the tractor trailer load. The extended hours also provide convenience for the per-

son who has to get in early in the morning or can't make it until late at night. There's more to the Mill St. Coin Laundry than just

washing machines and dryers. It's worth the trip just to drop by and have the satisfaction of using the facilities of a Miltowne Centre participant who, like all the Miltowne merchants, gives service which is a cut above the rest.
