Some programs wouldn't be affected at all. Teachers will have more courses but their workload will not go beyond the 20-hours per week negotiated in their contracts. The college expects to save \$550,000 from this area alone. No teacher layoffs are antic-

As well, the college is going to begin a review whether or not the position will be filled. Most service areas have al ready had to reduce or eliminate both essential non-essential projects for this fiscal

Ministry Education has given the school a 16 per cent increase in its post-secondary school grant over last year. But when the projected decrease for fees from part-time students is added the college expects to receive an overall increase of only 14 per cent.

The ministry's grant represents about 60 per cent of the school's operating revenue with the remainder coming from tuition fees bookstore profits, and rental income from the Lorne Park Campus and per diem revenues for retraining activities.

Enrolment of full-time students is expected to rise by seven per cent to 5,936 students this September. The number of full-time retraining students is expected to be 2,000 and the number of services community students is expected to be
