Trading Post popular buy-sell spot at show

According to Brad Clements, there's a better than average chance you'll be able to find it at the Milton Mercantile and Trading Post, a regular feature of the annual Steam-Era reunion.

Mr. Clements, who has been supervising the trading post many years for the Ontario Steam and Antique Preservers Association says it has become a very popular

part of the show. "Almost all of the club members whistling through here two or three times a day to see what's new," he

The trading post is operated by Mr. Clements and helpers. Items are left with him on consignment, with the club taking a 10 per cent commission

Most of the customers and dealers using the trading post, he said, are members of the club and other interested people.






