
WHEN CAN MORTGAGE

very specifically laid out in the Interest Act. If you have a conventional loan on your property, it may be paid off at any time after the first five years at a cost of three months' interest. If you have an NHA mortgage on your property, the rules

vary with the source of the funds. If the NHA mortgage funds come from an approved lender of C.M.H.C. and the loan is not in default, the borrower has the privilege of paying an additional amount of principal, not

in excess of 10% of the original amount of the mortgage on the first, second, or third anniversary or any month after the third anniversary. In each case, three months' interest


