

now, the Department Consumer and Corporate Affairs has received numerous complaints from consumers as to the quantity of wood in a cord, as used by firewood merchants.

The problem is we have two definitions for a cord of wood. The first concerns pulpwood and firewood cut into fourfoot lengths (this is the only legal definition), measures 128 cubic

feet (8x4x4 feet). The second concerns cut firewood, is not legally recognized and measures 32 cubic feet (8x4x1 feet). This latter measurement various terms such as bush cord or stove

problems having to do with these matters arise because deliberate fraud, but rather because each party to the transaction has a different definition of what a cord of wood is.

Since firewood is classified as either or hardsoftwood wood, consideration should also be given to the type of wood being purchased.

Softwoods, such as spruce, pine and fir are easy to ignite. It is best to use softwoods only for kindling, because they produce large amounts of dark. strong smelling creosote. During a very fire, creosote deposits in the chimney form a sticky substance may ignite which causing a chimney Chimney fires weaken the fireplace masonry and may

result in house fires. The ideal fire log is hardwood-dense heavy-that slowly. and popular are good examples hardwood many trees available.

following trees are common listed in descending order of their wood's fuel value (the first is best, the last, least): Hickory, Oak, Beech, Sugar Maple, Yellow Birch, and Poplar.
