Hard times can't kill dream of business

Ontarians sure are a sturdy lot. As unemployment figures and interest rates spiral relentlessly upward, so do the statistics for new businesses in Ontario.

The tougher the economic times, the more Ontarians seem to want to venture into a business of their own.

Despite the fact that new businesses fail at the disheartening rate of about 70 per cent within the first five years of their operation, the number of new businesses starting in Ontario has been increasing steadily since at least 1975.

In the fiscal year ending March 31, 1981, a total of 82,546 new businesses were registered or incorporated with the Ontario Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations, up from a total of 77,753 for the previous year.

These latest figures are almost 74 per cent higher than the 1974-75 total of 47,463, for example.

But business failures have also been sharply on the rise. In 1980, a total of 2,622 businesses went bankrupt in Ontario, up from 2,223 for 1979, according to the Bankruptcy Branch of the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs.

"The number of business bankruptcies has been on the increase.

Although there is no guaranteed formula for success, certain guidelines will stack the odds in your favor.

Most business experts agree that lack of planning is one of the main contributors to business failure.

Before you launch into a small business venture, be sure you have a clear idea of the way your business will operate, who your customers will be and where the markets are.
