And in a manger laid."

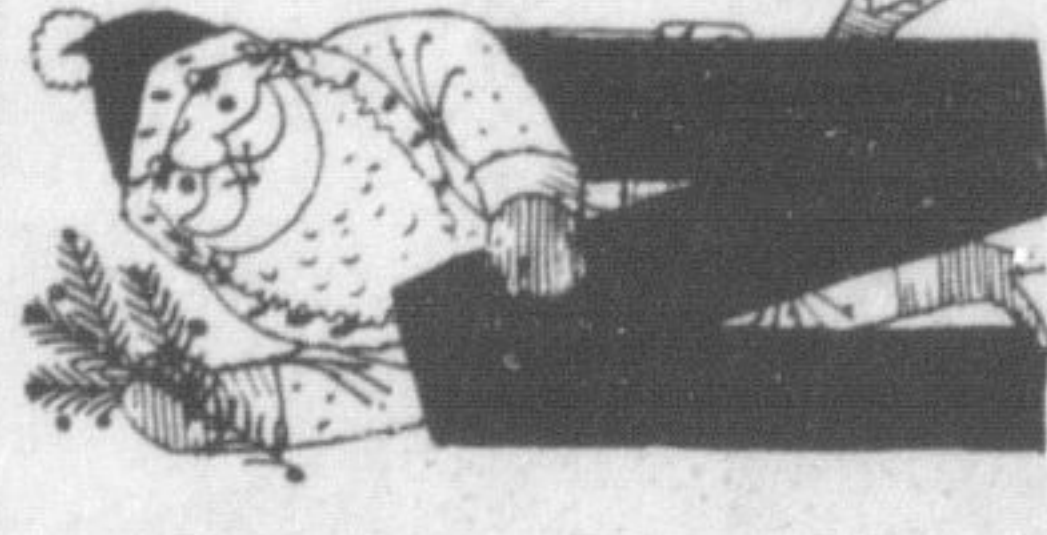
Thus spake the seraph, and forthwith,
