Xmas dinner at Harrop House

The Milton District University Women's Club held its annual Christmas Dinner on Thursday Dec. 3, 1981 at Harrop House in Milton. This well known landmark, in the town of Milton, proved to provide a lovely, traditional setting for the Christmas get-together of members. The delicious meal festively introduced the Christmas season. Billie Marshall, appropriately, gave a talk on the history of Harrop House. The land, said Billie, where the house is built, was deeded to William Ellis in 1822 and the magnificent house was subsequently built in about 1854. One of the daughters of William Elliot, said Billie, taught her at school in Milton. The Harrops purchased the house in 1912 and had a dairy, which supplied Milton residents with milk door-to-door for many years. Older Milton residents remember the daffodil display every spring on the lawn at the Harrop House. The magnificent red-painted barn, which belonged to the Harrop farm, was moved just a few years ago to the Ontario Agricultural Museum. The University Women's Club will be holding its annual used book sale on April 30 and May 1, 1982—so please keep your old books and keep this date in mind.
