Islands Thrown Up in

South Atlantic Ocean In a few hundred thousand years, whole new archipelago like Japan may emerge from the south Atlantic ocean. This forecast has been made by Rev. Frederick W. Sohon, Georgetown university seismologist, after reports of the discovery of two new islands in P.O. Box 384. the region, coupled with simultaneous seismograph records showing earth tremors that might have emanated from the same territory. The islands appeared off the coast of Brazil, and at first some scientists suggested that they might mean the reappearance of the so-called "lost continent of Atlantis." Father Sohon said there is a ridge along the ocean bed equi-distant between South America and Africa, but if there ever was a continent there, it had been completely destroyed. The modern development, he believes, is the result of thousands of, years of erosion, sending rock from the mountains down to the continental shelf of the Americas. This, he said, might pile up so much weight that the pressure would cause a ridge in the




