Heavy Fine For Chicken Theft.

Burlington, April 30.—Clifford Beamer, of Carlisle, appeared before Magistrate William Barr this morning on a charge of chicken stealing, and was fined a total of \$125. In addition, the chickens which he stole back in October, 1929, have been paid for. Friends of the accused young man, who is now employed, requested that some leniency be shown, providing Beamer agreed to pay for all damage done. The chickens that Beamer took netted him the princely sum of \$8, so that he is considerably over \$100 out on the bargain. After the theft Beamer could not be traced by the police, and "or about two years his whereabouts were unknown. About a month ago Chief Lee Smith spotted the accused near Carlisle and placed him under arrest. Beamer will pay his fine at the rate of \$10 per month.

An Unfairness Rectified.

By an amendment to the Municipal Act, passed at the recent session of the Legislature, villages are now given the same power to govern hawkers and peddlars as was formerly enjoyed by towns and cities. The changing of two words in the bill gives a village a protection which has a long felt want, and enables them to pass legislation to protect against transient traders. Action Council, at its session on Monday night, started to take action on the new provision and it is hoped that the fees will be sufficient to make the provisions of the Act protective. The bill was introduced in the Legislature by T. P. Lancaster, M. P. for Peterborough County, and Village Councils all over the Province will be grateful that this seeming unfairness against the villages has been finally rectified.—Acton Free Press.

Georgetown Arena Has Deficit.

Georgetown, April 28.—Directors of the Georgetown Arena elected last night are as follows: E. McWhiters, W. V. Grant, W. H. Kentner, G. Cleave, A. T. S. V. King and E. R. Ovington. Owing to the rather mild winter causing lack of ice in the arena, the treasurer was forced to report a small deficit in operation expenses. The directors are confident, however, that this will be erased as soon as the box lacrosse team is organized. The team will play its home games at the arena.

Hit by Car, George Pell Gets \$3,500.

(Toronto Daily Star, May 2.) Claiming \$7,500 damages for injuries received when struck by a motor car, George Pell, Halton county farmer, this afternoon was awarded a verdict for \$3,500 with costs by an assize court jury before Chief Justice Rose. Suit was against Donald S. and Donald P. Robertson, Milton.

Graduate Exercises of Guelph General Hospital.

Quite a number of interested district Miltonians motored to Guelph, Thursday evening last, to witness the class of 1932 nurses, of the Guelph General Hospital, graduate promptly at 8.30 o'clock, with Miss Marion Ford at the piano, playing the professional march. The graduating class, numbering 14, entered looking smart and trim in their white uniforms and each carrying an armful of red roses. Dr. Fowler, Chairman of the Hospital Board, acted as chairman for the evening in his usual bright and witty manner. He tendered Milton a high compliment on the good-looking ladies they send out to train as nurses, which met with a hearty applause from all Miltonians present. Miss Edith Cartwright was the one nurse graduating while Miss Mary I. Stark was the other, the latter winning the prize donated by the Board of Directors of the Guelph General Hospital for standing first in General Proficiency in the class.

The Department Saves Alone

Even the school pupils are called upon to assist in raising additional funds. The Departmental examinations, which formerly cost a dollar per paper will be \$1.50 per paper this year. The maximum for Middle School students is \$10; Upper School pupils \$15; and Lower School examinees a maximum of \$5. Just at a time when students' parents may find it difficult to keep the children at school, the increase in the fees is not an incentive to continuance of education. For presiding officers and their assistants at Entrance examinations have been reduced from \$5 and \$7 per day respectively to \$2.50 and \$3. Fees for reading answer papers of Entrance candidates have been reduced from \$1.50 to \$1.25 per pupil. Each pupil is given eight papers. At any rate, the Department is out to save money, but there appears to be no assistance tendered to those who make an effort to give the children the advantage of education.
