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TOWN COUNCIL.
Council Tuesday night discussed the problem of window peepers who are disturbing residents and decided to install additional street lights. It was stated it might be necessary to hire extra night-watchmen to curb the practice.

The issuance of \$14,000 in debentures was authorized.

A report on means of reducing unemployment submitted by Councillor George E. Elliott caused a lengthy discussion. The report suggested much needed street improvements, redecoration of the town hall and gardens for the unemployed, extension of the waterworks, with a view to future installation of a sewerage system, was also advocated.

Mayor Sykes was opposed to the issuance of the report because the town, he felt, was in no condition to consider such expenditures.

Reeve Ramsbaw said he thought it would be a good idea to get something in return for the money being spent on relief. The general feeling appeared to be in favor of the report, which was tabled for consideration at the next meeting of the council on Tuesday, April 17th, at 8 p.m.
