# Garden Festival ends Sunday

Eighteen gardening groups will combine under the umbrella of the Civic Garden Centre of Toronto to demonstrate their specialties at Garden Festival '86 in February.

At the same time, the Niagara Parks Commission's School of Horticulture will be marking its 50th anniversary with a special "calendar of bloom" at the festival.

Garden Festival runs until Sunday, Feb. 16 at the International Centre, 6900 Airport Road, Mississauga.

The Ontario Rock Garden Society will be constructing a rocky and waterfall as its exhibit while the Canadian Wildflower Society will be showing wildflowers through the seasons.

The University of Guelph will have a display on pest diagnosis and control as well as an educational exhibit.

The Civic Garden itself will have a display of exhibition size amaryllis as well as an extensive information area, and two sample window areas featuring plants for the kitchen and bathroom.

Students from the Niagara Parks Commission School of Horticulture will give specialized presentations at their display.

Garden Festival is two shows in one — the Flower and Garden Show with thousands of fragrant blooms and plants in the middle of winter and the Pool and Spa Show, featuring the latest in swimming pools, saunas, spas and outdoor furniture.
