

# Royals show their best and worst

Milton Royals showed how good they can be and how bad they can be in Central Ontario senior baseball action on the weekend.

Royal City Realty defeated Burlington, one of the top clubs in the league, 12-9 Saturday but lost 12-3 to St. Catharines Sunday. Both games were played at Milton's Brian Best Park.

Southpaw Dave Turner pitched strong relief Saturday, coming in for Mario Galvao one out shy of four innings. Turner threw the remainder of the game and threw well, allowing only two hits and no runs for the rest of the contest.

Burlington started Gord Ritchie, who allowed eight runs, all earned, and went with Brad Syms in the fifth.

Syms threw effective relief, allowing no runs over his three-inning stint. But he got into trouble in the eighth. Milton scored four runs as Syms retired and Burlington used Adam Hanna and Jamie Crompton in short relief.

Against St. Catharines, Milton had a big eighth inning again, but it was their only scoring inning. Tim Rowden went the distance to hold Milton to three runs, all earned, while Rick McTrach shouldered the loss.

Milton stranded most of their scoring chances against St. Catharines, as they collected 12 hits but could only connect for three runs. St. Kitts turned 10 hits into 12 runs.

The day before Milton mounted the

same 12-hit attack, and scored 12 times.

Burlington and Milton switched momentum and initiative throughout the game's early innings Saturday. Milton scored three times in the first but Burlington came back with five in the second. Milton responded with one in the third to tie it at seven but Burlington scored twice in the fourth for their last two runs. Royals added one in the fourth to trail by one.

Turner and Syms faced off, keeping the scoreboard clean until things fell apart for Burlington in the eighth.

Turner set down the side in order in the eighth and Gerry Milne started

Royals on the comeback trail with a stand-up triple. Glen Turner walked to put runners on the corners. Gary Naylor singled to score Milne and advance Turner to third. Galvao doubled to score Turner and Naylor. Galvao advanced on a passed ball and scored on John Turner's squeeze bunt.

Milton loaded the bases in the first inning. Paul Blackmore walked, Milne took first on an error and Glen Turner singled to load the bases. Naylor took first on a fielder's choice, a pick-off attempt at second, and Blackmore scored on the play.

Galvao singled to score Milne and Turner.

In the second inning, Norm Mowbray singled, Blackmore walked and Glen Turner singled to load the bases. Naylor batted a single to score the two lead runners.

In the third, Blackmore singled in Mowbray, who was safe on a fielder's choice, for a run. In the fourth, Milne singled and scored on Galvao's single.

Galvao and McTrach hit singles to score Glen Turner and Naylor, who had both singled, against St. Kitts. Bob Basadur, who had singled, scored on a fielder's choice.

# Rangers down rival MFC 2-0

Youth triumphed over experience Wednesday night as Milton's two Inter-County soccer squads faced off at Robert Baldwin pitch.

At least that's the way Bob Gibson saw it.

"It was a good night for us," the Can Travel Rangers player-coach said. "It was a hard game but we had the legs and we pulled it off."

Gibson's Rangers downed rival Milton Football Club 2-0, and the game went pretty well according to Hoyle, Gibson said.

Gibson had been reluctant to unveil his game plan prior to the contest but afterward he felt it had worked effectively.

"We wanted to take control of the middle of the park and we did that. George Socha, Clive King, Anthony Goodban and I did that. There's no doubt we controlled the middle of the park. Fifteen or 20 minutes into the game we felt it wouldn't be a one-way street for them."

Bob Adamson and King scored for Rangers, with both goals in the first half. Adamson scored when he banged in a header following Bernie Dominie's corner kick. Dominie, who played a strong game, was responsible for the second goal set-up too.

Dominie was zeroing in on the MFC net when he was pulled down, forcing a penalty kick, and King cashed in on it.

Gibson was pleased with the amount of offensive pressure Rangers generated, but not so much

so with its results. "We had lots of shots on net but not as many goals as would like. But that will come."

Gibson has signed goaltender Andrew King, to start tonight (Wednesday) against Georgetown in Georgetown. "He's played since he

was four years old," Gibson noted.

One of Milton's stronger players, Rob Holliday, played for a short period of time against MFC. Holliday is on the mend from an ankle injury and is expected to be 100 per cent fit for next week.
