Meet your feathered friends this Sunday at Mountsberg

Mountsberg Wildlife Center is once again inviting all bird lovers, naturalists and those who enjoy the outdoors to "Friends of a Feather" Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The day is devoted entirely to our fine feathered friends and visitors will experience a variety of interesting activities from bird banding to falconry.

The day begins with a Morning Bird Hike from 9-10:30 a.m. where visitors are bound to see some interesting sightings.

Martin Wernart, Mountsberg's licenced bird bander, will demonstrate the technique of bird banding and visitors have a chance to "Adopt A Bird". That program was begun in 1965 to help raise funds for equipment and research into wild bird

populations. For \$5 visitors can adopt a wild bird and see it banded and released. That session runs from 10:30-11:30 a.m.

"Birds In My Backyard" is presented from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and shows people how to identify birds around the home. Participants will learn how to attract more and create a garden for birds which is the presentation from 12:30-1:30 p.m.

Dr. Roy Anderson, chairperson from the University of Guelph, will offer an interesting session entitled "Parasites of Our Birds" that is held from 1:30-2 p.m. Mountsberg education co-ordinator Jim Aitkenhead will conduct a bird hike from 1-2 p.m. and then visitors will be invited to tour the Wildlife Walkway from 2:30-4 p.m.
