The Public is invited to review this application and provide comments or express concerns in writing to Regional Council within a period of 30 days from the date of publication of this Notice.

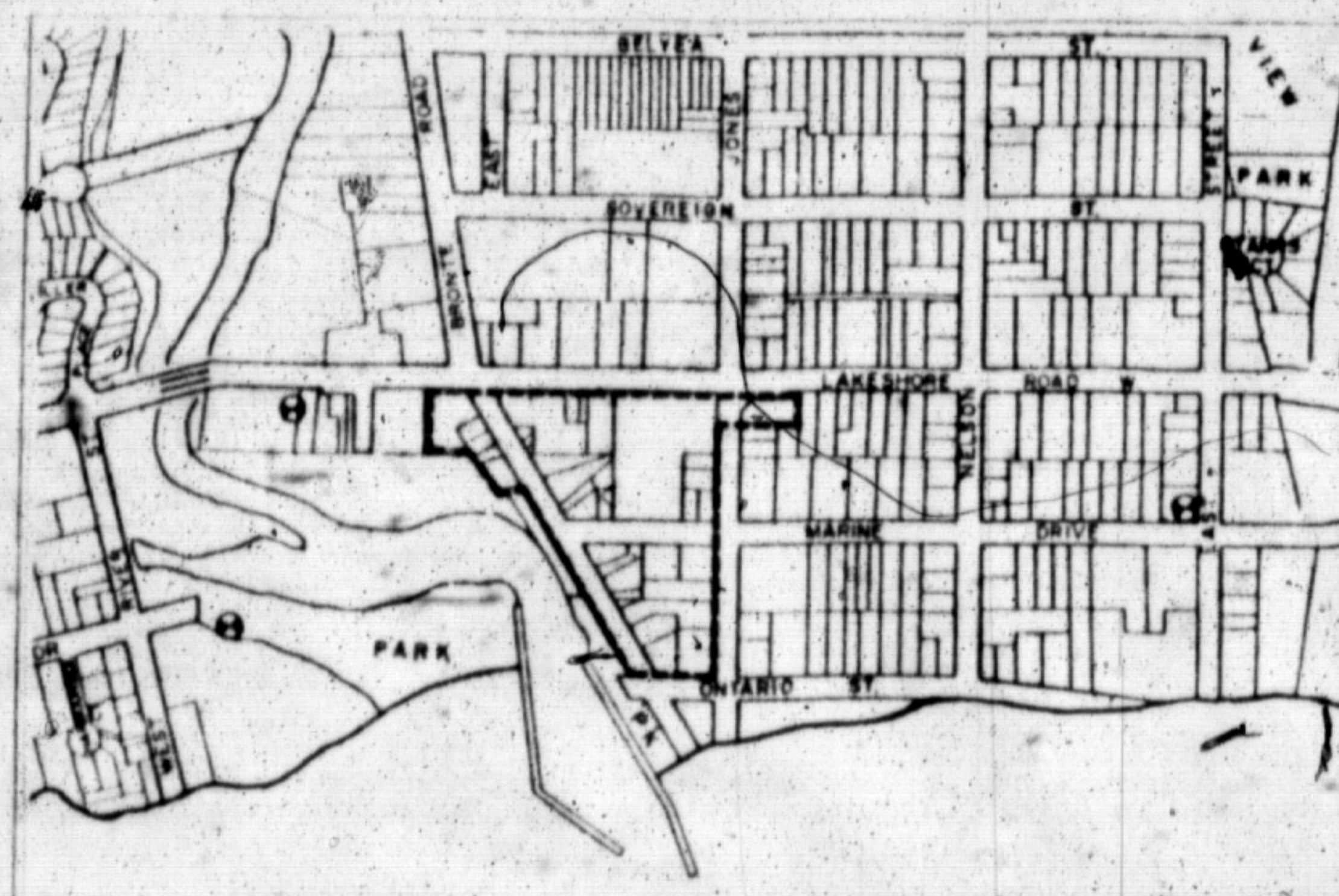
