

Board reviews busy year at hospital

Milton District Hospital chairman Tom Richardson said last year was one of the busiest for the hospital.

He credited the completion of the facility's expansion and renovation for making 1987 so hectic. The new wing was officially opened on Oct. 16.

Mr. Richardson was speaking at the hospital's annual general meeting. He presented the new hospital logo designed by the Public Relations Committee, Hospital Auxiliary and Foundation. He also thanked several people for their contributions for last year including the citizens of Milton, the Building and Property Committee, the Medical Advisory Staff, and medical staff.

Several employees who have been with the hospital for many years were recognized.

Five year-employees included: Isabel Trimble, Bonnie Trollope, Mary Zacharia, Erika Gyger, Anne Kunze, Judy Mizuk, Gayle Gartley, Joan Smith and David Tonelli. Lynda Gervais was recognized for 10 years, and Geraldine Hickey and Betty Bell received pins for 15 years, while Edith Moschoi and Cathy McMillan were honoured for their 20 years of service.

Four members of the board retired. David Katz, who joined the board in 1980 as the appointee of the region completed his term. For the past year Mr. Katz served as chairman of the building and property committee.

Also retiring is Greg Allamano who served as treasurer for the past six years, and June MacLeod who has completed 11 years on the board.

Mr. Richardson has also completed his final term as a member of

Joyce Fowler, president of the Hospital Auxiliary, presented a cheque for \$20,000 raised by the auxiliary over the past year. The money will be used for equipment.

She spoke to those at the meeting about the many auxiliary fund-

raising activities including the annual strawberry fair, fall fashion show, garage sale and various draws.

The auditors report was presented and prepared by H.D. Mullin Chartered Accountant. The financial statement showed total assets of Milton District Hospital, as of March 31, were \$2,394,962. At that time current liability was \$1,325,653.

Gross revenue was \$10,606,393, while gross expenses were \$10,291,510, leaving an excess of revenue of \$314,883.

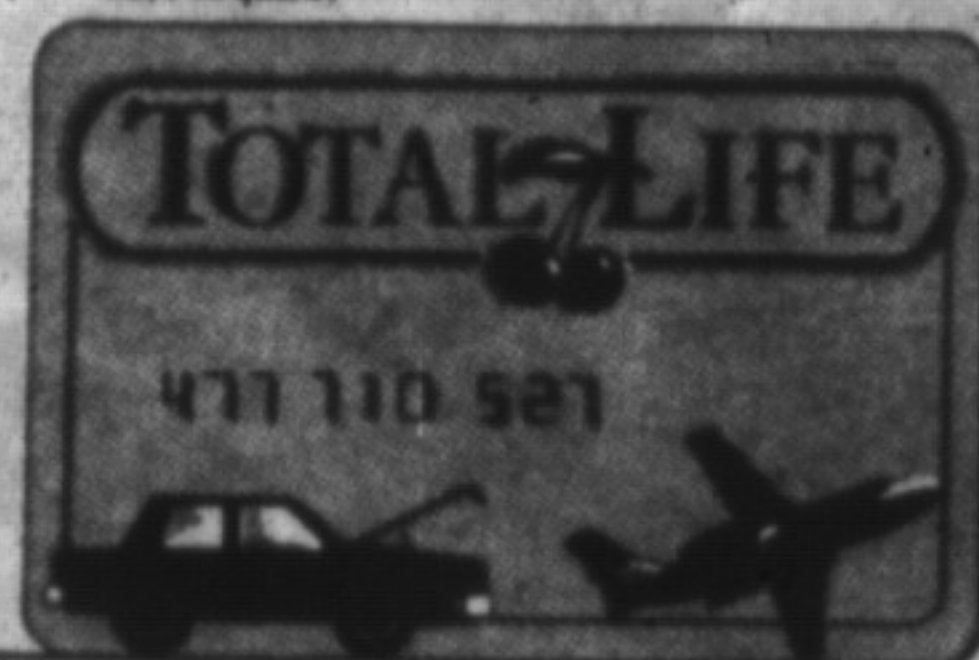
