**Classes for parents expecting multiple births**

Couples who are expecting a multiple birth will have a chance to prepare through a course being offered at a Sheridan College.

The special childbirth classes, *Preparing for Twins—A Multiple Approach*, will be held from July 19 to August 23 at the Oakville Campus. The course is taught by Joyce MacKenzie, an executive member of the Burlington Twins Club, who is a twin and the mother of twins.

The six sessions cover the normal process of plural pregnancy and birth, prevention of pre-term birth, nutrition and exercise, breastfeeding and caring for more than one baby and related topics.

Concerns of participants will be shared.

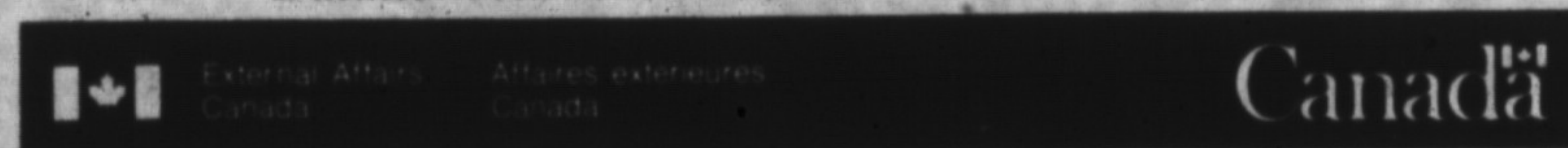

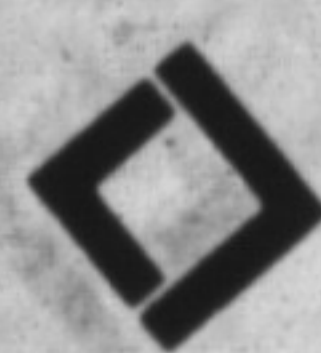

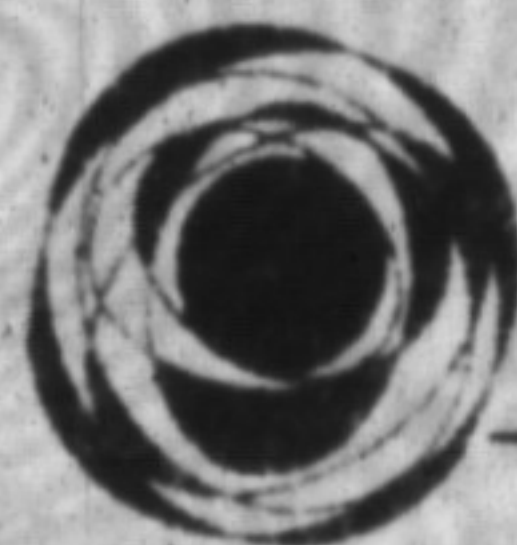
