The first time Georgetown got the ball, after the opening touchdown, they fumbled the ball on their first play from scrimmage. The ball was recovered by Mike Antonucci of Milton. The blow that jarred the ball. loose was delivered by Darren Goertzen.

Milton wasted no time in turning that into points, with Swarbrick splitting the uprights on a 22-yard field goal giving Milton a 10-0 lead.

The Georgetown woes continued when a fumble occurred on their second try at running a play. This time the loose ball was jumped on by David Wheelihan.

Once again, Milton turned the gift into points with Jim Speck scoring on a one-yard run. Once again Swarbrick hailed the convert.

That wasn't to be the end of the Milton first-half scoring though. On the ensuing kickoff, the last play of the half it turns out, Georgetown fumbled the football deep into the endzone and were forced to concede a single point, making the halftime score 18-0.

Georgetown came out in the second half looking like a new team. They took the opening kickoff and drove 80 yards, threatening to get on the scoreboard. That threat was short-lived, though, when the Rebels decided to put the ball in the air on this windy day. It was picked off by Swarbrick.

Turnovers continued to plague both teams, but neither could put any points on the scoreboard and the game ended 18-0.

"We planned on running the ball when we came into the game," said a very satisfied Keith Pearce, the head coach of the Mustangs. "I'm really pleased with the way we ran the ball."

Running the ball was certainly the strong point for the Mustangs. Both Speck and Steve Fleet gained more than 100 yards on the day while Fleet, the fullback, also provided exceptional blocking for both the quarterback and the other runners.

According to defensive coach Ian Newell, the Milton defenders played

an exceptional game. .

"Our guys were breaking through their offensive line and causing some real hell in their backfield. The boys worked extremely well as a team and showed a lot of spirit," he

Other defenders praised by Newell include Mike Walker, the defensive captain, and linemen Ken Wilkinson and Paul Moreau.


