## Eleanor Calbes to perform with St. Paul's choir

Renowned soprano Eleanor Calbes will join St. Paul's United Church Choir Saturday evening for a benefit concert in aid of the church's organ restoration fund.

Named the 1986 Musician of the Year for Mississauga, Ms Calbes has appeared on the Tonight Show with Johnny Carson; as soloist with the Chicago Symphony; and performed the leading soprano in the world premiere of the Philippine Grand Opera. She is well-known on three continents, North America, Europe and Asia.

Locally she's known as a teacher of voice. Ms Calbes is artistic director and founder of the Mississauga City Centre Opera Company. She received the coveted T.H.E.A.' award as best director in a musical for her excellent work in *The King and I* for the Brampton Musical Society.

Contributing to the concert with Ms Calbes and the church choir, (directed by Judy Hunter) will be saxophonist Greg Edgar, soloists Judy Hunter, Grace Hildebrand, Jack Thomson, Shyamala Kirshan and the Keiso Trio.

Tickets at \$6 for adults and \$5 for seniors and students are available at the church office or from members of the choir.

## Students can join exchange

Interculture Canada is now selecting next year's class of young Canadians aged 15-18 to travel overseas for a school year.

Interculture is the country's leading international student exchange and is a non-profit charitable organization.

Students now have the chance to enrich their horizons by living and learning in an environment completely different for the one they live in.

There are more than 200 home and study stays available in any of 32 different countries so students are urged to have the chance of a lifetime.

Winter destinations such as Brazil, Australia and Japan have few placements available but they are now pushing towards summer destinations around the world. Students are backed by the support of a local volunteer counsellor while on their stay.

Participation fees can be compared with the amount spent on a student over a regular year and financial support is available for disadvantaged families. Interculture is a member of the world's largest network of intercultural exchange, now operating in more than 70 countries.

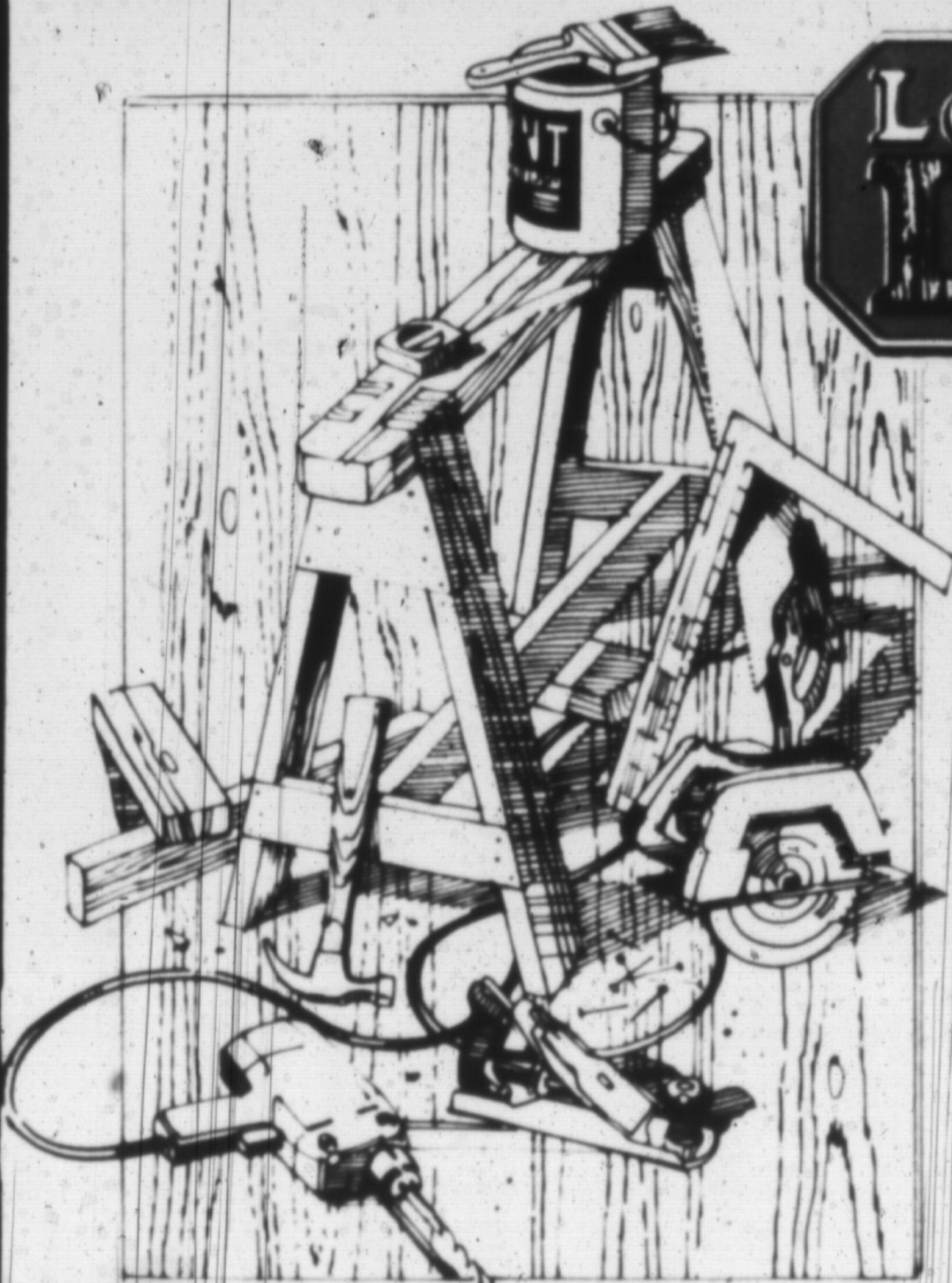
The new look of the former Charles Hotel on Main Street began with the facelift to the Sportsman's

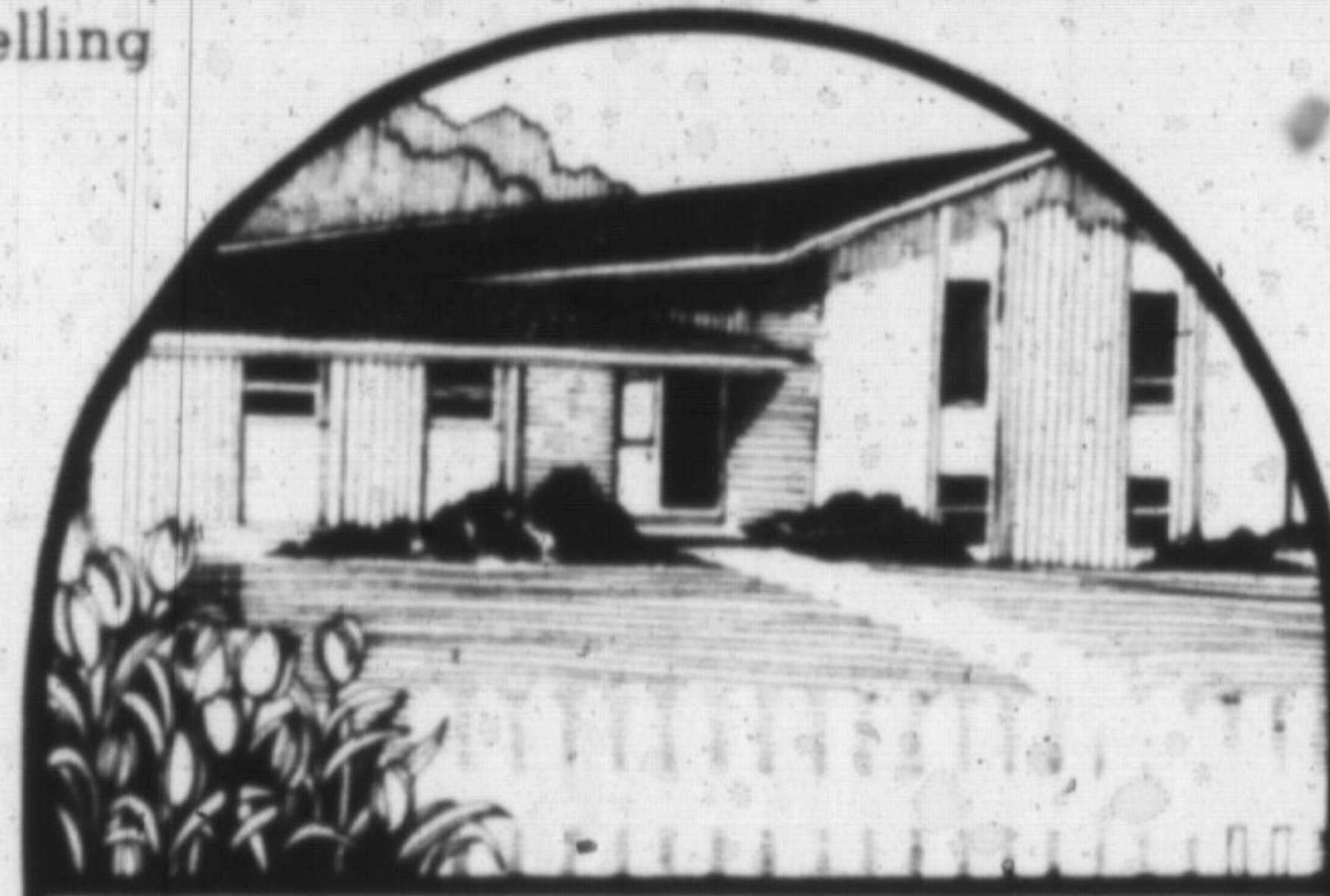
