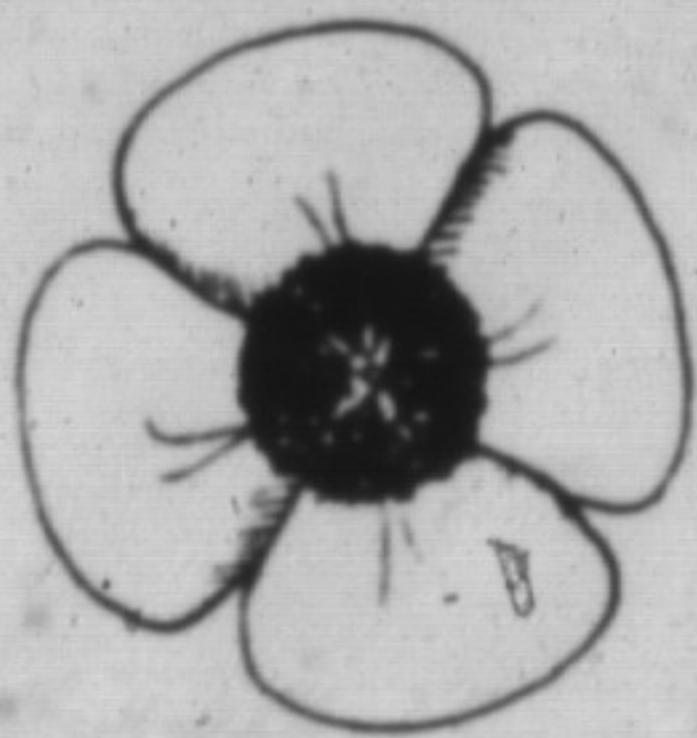

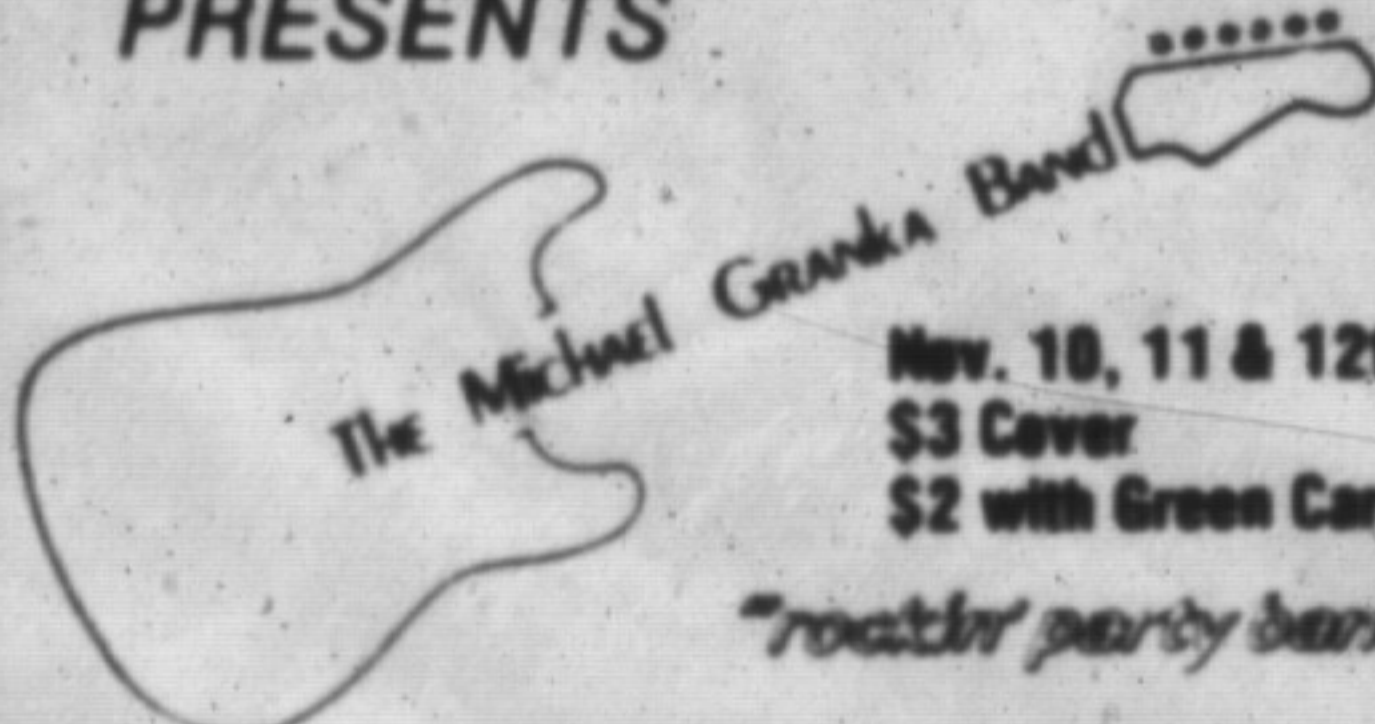


### Private Lives
