

# Half a ton of local library books are bound for Jamaica

More than 1,200 books, from Milton Public Library will soon become part of the collection at the St. James Parish Library near Montego Bay, Jamaica.

The books, more than 1,000 pounds of hard cover editions, were sorted and packed earlier this week.

The project is part of a larger one which the Milton Public Library undertook last year. As part of the Book Development Project, funds have been set aside over the next few years to expand the public library's collection.

The plan also includes removing from the collection any damaged or outdated non-circulating books.

Several of the books are sold to the public. However Milton Public Library Board decided that some of the hard cover books, which were mostly adult fiction, would be better utilized on the shelves of Jamaica's hurricane damaged libraries.

"We made a point of sending only good quality books," said Lorie Jocius member of the Library board.

"Many of them are duplicates of books, that don't circulate as much as they used to. They are not too outdated that they could be of some value."

"We have sent down several leisure reading books. Because they don't have access to many books like them," said Jane Watkins chief librarian. "We have included some real good classics."

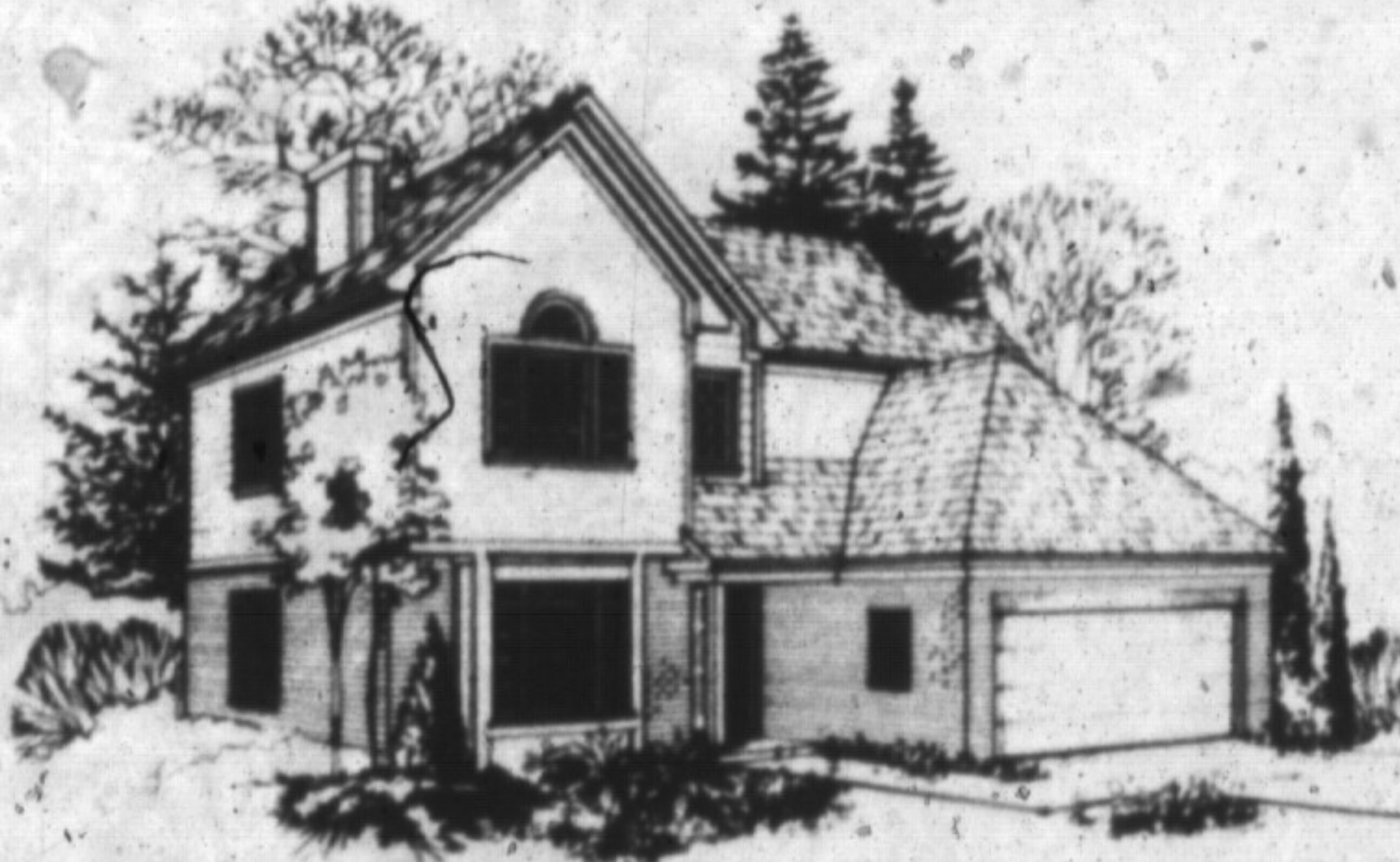

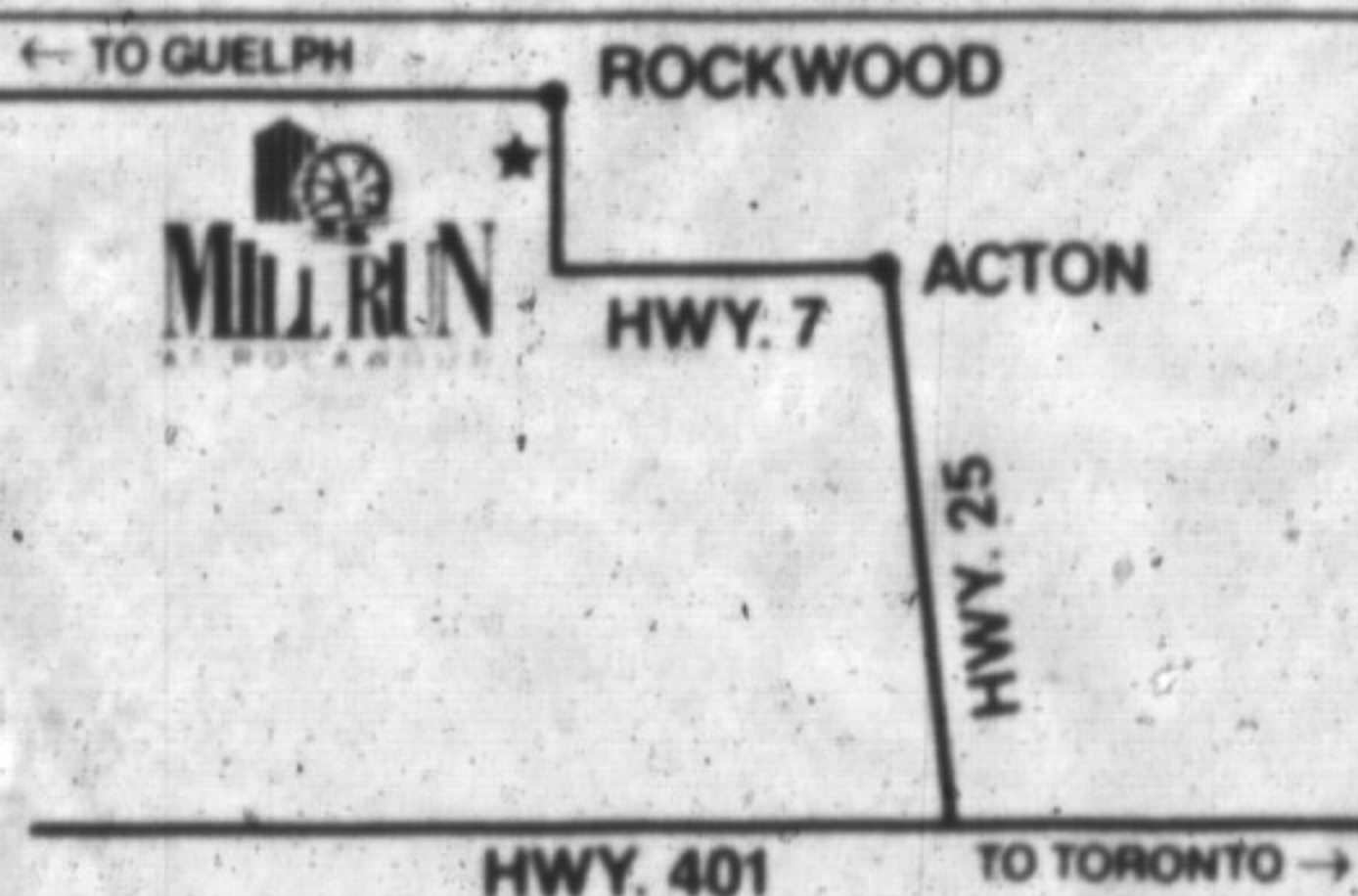
