

# Photo-degradable garbage bags available for Pitch-In

There should be a lot more people "pitching in" when the Pitch-In Ontario Campaign takes place May 1-7.

There will be 50 per cent more Pitch-In bags available to schools and community groups participating in the province-wide clean-up project.

The increase is the result of the sponsorship of NOVA and Polysar which are providing photo-degradable bags to Pitch-In.

The Pitch-In bags will include a new additive "Ecolyte" which makes the plastic bags photo-

degradable. Pitch-In co-ordinators have distributed more than 10,000 comprehensive information packs to schools, Scouts, Guides, Chambers of Commerce, local government and many community-based organizations to make them aware of the campaign.

"Each kit contains colourful posters, suggestions for projects, a newsletter and a host of other information materials," said Jack Craik, president of the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters, sponsors of the Pitch-In campaign in Ontario.

The packages contain order forms for the special garbage bags.

"I urge all participating groups to return the order form for garbage bags promptly and well before March 31," Mrs. Craik said.

Last year more than 400 volunteer groups had to be disappointed as supplies of bags ran out. This year, however, it is hoped all who apply will receive at least some of the new bags.
