Price of land severance already too expensive

Dear Editor:

I am writing in regard to comments made by Murray Harris in a meeting concerning our Land Division Committee. According to an article in The Champion, Mr. Harris suggested land severance application fees should be raised from \$350 to \$1,500. The fees for a land severance are high enough because they involve other fees.

1) Dedicate any lands within 15 metres (46 feet) from the centre

line of the road.

2) After receiving consent the landowner must pay a lot levy of \$800 to the Town of Milton.

3) The property must be surveyed at a cost of \$185.

4) A well must be drilled and it must be inspected by the health department.

5) If required by the town, the severance must be fenced.

6) Upon approval, \$1,404 must be paid to Halton Region as a capital contribution.

7) The applicant must pay an administration fee of \$120 at the time approval is given to the severance.

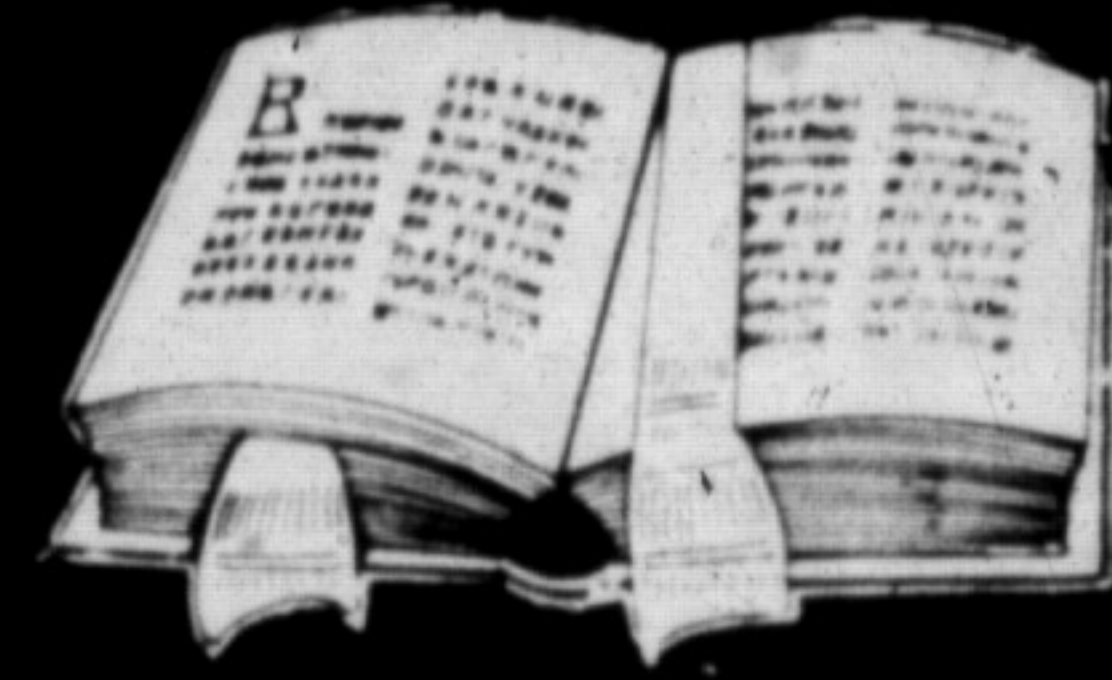
Mr. Harris should do some mathematics.
