

Library searching for town's fastest worm

The Milton Public Library is bringing new meaning to the term bookworm. In search of the fastest worm, the library will host the first annual Milton Worm Race July 21 at 2 p.m.

To be eligible to race, all entries must be named after an author or scientist and arrive in a suitable container, provided with adequate soil and air.



A circle will be drawn on a square piece of board and entries will be placed in each of the four corners. The worm that makes the furthest progression toward the centre of the circle after two minutes will win.

A variety of races will be held and winners will receive prizes.

Jane Venus, children's librarian and organizer of the event, said the idea for the competition came from the Burlington Public Library, which runs such a race.

The library will not be responsible for supplying worms to grieving owners of deceased worms or to owners who lose their entries, said Ms Venus.

Owners who step on other owners' entries or argue over ownership will be eliminated from the competition.

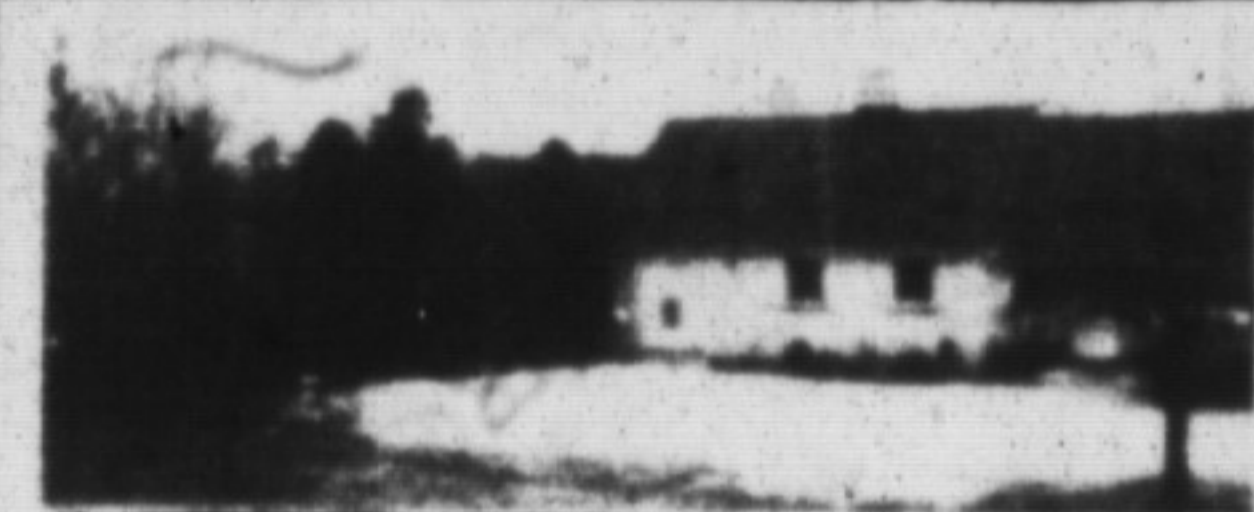

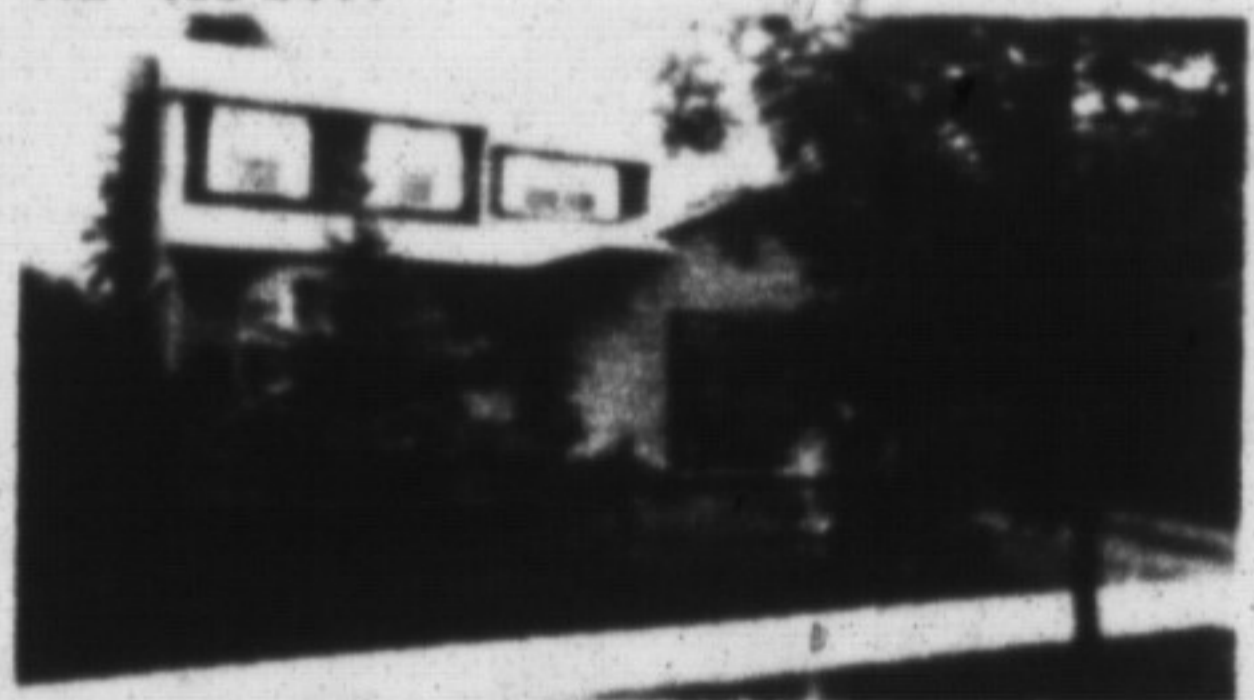
