Give your air conditioner a little late season love

At this time of year, your central air conditioner has put in some hard-working months. Now is a good time to give it an extra thorough cleaning so it can keep on delivering comfort through the remaining warm weeks.

Grass clippings and debris fallen from trees are the main enemies. These clog the grills and make it difficult for the fan to cool the unit. As a result, the unit must work

much harder to produce a satisfactory cooling effect in your home. This will waste electricity. And it can lead the unit to age prematurely.

Cleaning is mainly a matter of hosing the unit down. Don't be afraid to do this. It's sealed inside, so water can't do any damage.

If there are dogs loose in your neighbourhood you have another reason to hose your air conditioner down - and frequently. Dog urine is highly corrosive. It can literally eat

through the cooling fins on your unit. And this damage is not likely to be covered under a manufacturer's warranty.

Another problem air conditioners may encounter, especially older ones, is freon leak. This will cause the unit to work too hard.

If you have a freon problem, your house will tell you. You will notice your unit running more than seems normal, but the house will not cool down readily. If you suspect you have this problem call a serviceman im-

mediately. You cannot correct this yourself. To neglect the problem could lead to costly breakdown.

Air conditioners are manufactured to endure many years of the tough Canadian climate. Give a good system a little loving care and it could last as long as you live in your house.




