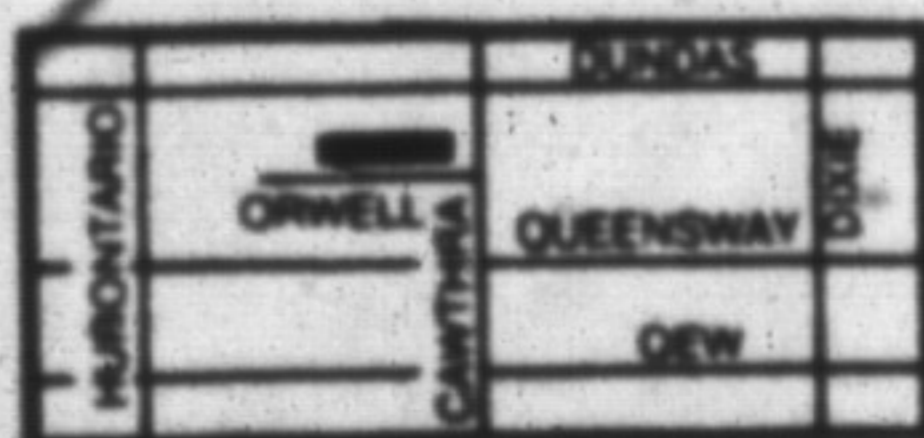

Sept. 15 at the Boyne MP to speak at dinner-dance

The Oakville-Milton Woman's Club is hosting a dinner dance at the Boyne Community Centre Friday Sept. 15. The guest speaker will be the Honourable Ralph Ferguson, former federal minister of agriculture and MP for Lambton-Middlesex.

Mr. Ferguson has extensive farming experience and has participated in various agricultural organizations, including pork, grain and poultry producers' associations and the National Farm Products Marketing Council.

Recently Mr. Ferguson has been active in the lobby which is opposed to the federal government's proposal to ban semi-automatic hunting rifles.

Mr. Ferguson is a conservationist, angler and hunter. He recently introduced an amendment to the Criminal Code of Canada which would allow farmers to protect their livestock from attacks and harassment by other animals, including domestic dogs.

Mr. Ferguson was first elected to Parliament in 1980 and served as parliamentary secretary to several cabinet ministers prior to assuming the post of agriculture minister in 1984. He was re-elected in 1988 and now serves as the agriculture co-critic for the Liberal party.

Others expected at the dinner include Walt Elliot, MPP for Halton Centre, and Doug Carrothers, MPP for Oakville South.
