She's sole survivor of class of '07

At the age of 92, Pearl Maxwell has outlived all her classmates who attended a one-room school house in 1907.

Looking back on a class photo taken during that year in Markham, Mrs. Maxwell feels fortunate and thankful for her long life, spent mostly in Milton.

"I'm lucky to be able to breathe," said Mrs. Maxwell jokingly.

She has kept in contact with some of her childhood classmates, and believes she is now the only one who hasn't passed away. Losing friends is a downfall of living to a ripe old age.

Born in Markham Township in 1897, Mrs. Maxwell moved from Toronto to Milton with her husband Norman in 1933 when the population of the town was between 2,000-3,000.

The couple purchased a farm near where the GO Station is today and lived there until 1957.

Over the years, Mrs. Maxwell has seen a number of changes in the town she has lived in for 56 years.

"When we first came here, we knew everybody downtown - now you feel like a stranger," she said. "It was more friendly when it was smaller, but you can't stand in the way of progress."
