Art sale to fund rural day care centre

A country welcome combined with fine art will make up the first annual Nassagaweya Art Show and Sale Nov. 17-18.

Featuring the works of more than 30 artists from surrounding areas, the two-day show will run Friday from 4 to 9:30 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Nassagaweya Community Centre.

Watercolours, oils and acrylics will be the main attraction, but graphite, gouache, pastels, porcelain painting and photography will also be included, said Betty Bassett of the organizing committee.

"We are focusing on a high quality art show," explained Mrs. Bassett. "Most of the work is original art, but some limited edition prints will be available. Prices will range from \$45 to \$4,000 so there will be something for everyone and every budget."

After 10 months of planning, a selection committee reviewed art submitted by artists from the area surrounding Nassagaweya, narrowing the exhibit to 24

booths representing 38 artists.

The artists selected include: Ruth Mudge and Barbara Ayres of Campbellville; Brigitte Schreyer of Milton; Elizabeth Pudsey and Tina Van der Ahe of Burlington; Pat MacDowell, Lynne Frederick, EvaMarie Moyle, Doris Law and Hans Lieferink of Oakville; Gloria Gefl, Sibylle Henrich-Rett of Kitchener; Roy Lefneski, John McCroery, John Mattar of Guelph; Terry McDonald of Mississauga; Leonie Holmes of Acton; Johanna VanKempen of Richmond Hill; Linda Kemp of Fenwick; Brian Romagnoli of Lincoln; and the Flamborough Fine Arts Association representing seven artists from Waterdown, Carlisle, Puslinch, Moffat and Campbellville.

In most cases, the artists will be present to answer questions and talk about their works, said Mrs. Bassett.

Opening ceremonies will take place Friday at 4:30 p.m. with dignitaries from all levels of government. Admission is \$2 for adults and \$1 for seniors and students. Children will be admitted free.
